RECOMMENDATIONS: The Executive Director recommends adoption of the following resolutions for Southern Oregon University:

INFORMATION:

OAR 584-400-0070, *State Recognition: Continuing Programs (Program Review Process)*, provides guidelines for the state's program review process, otherwise known as State Recognition of Programs. A program is a planned sequence of courses and experiences for the purpose of preparing educators to work in a P-12 setting.

Educator Preparation Providers (EPPs) are required to submit program reports for review as part of the accreditation process. EPPs may either submit reports to a national process (SPA review) or to the state program review process. They may also choose to use both review processes. For programs submitted to the SPA review process, the state program review is waived. SOU only used the state review process and did not have any SPA reviews.
