Renewing Your Oregon Educator License

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General Information

To *renew*, most license types require an application, fee, PEER form (if employed) and verification of PDUs:

- Application and fee: submitted through eLicensing
- **PEER form**: Contact your employing Oregon School District to have them complete this form. This form must be submitted
 - o By your Oregon school district through the eLicensing District Portal,
 - Emailed to contact.tspc@oregon.gov directly from the school district or
 - \circ $\;$ Received in a sealed school district envelope through the US Postal Service.
- **Continuing PDUs**: Are verified directly by your employer on a PEER form (see above) or our partner ESDs. PDU logs uploaded by the educator are not acceptable. Please review the "Continuing Professional Development Guide" for full details on Continuing PDUs.

NOTE: Continuing PDUs do not qualify you for a Professional License. Please review the "Upgrading to Professional" page for details on Advanced Professional Development.

A few license types require district sponsorship and proof of progress in your preparation program. Common document types required for reissuance of these sponsored licenses includes:

- **Employer Sponsorship**: Contact your employing Oregon school district to have them submit the letter to our office
- Official Transcript Submission
 - Electronic: tspc.transcripts@oregon.gov, received directly from the college.
 - Paper: 250 Division St NE, Salem, OR 97301. Must be received in a sealed university envelope.
 - Transcripts uploaded by the educator or not received in a sealed university envelope cannot be accepted as official and will delay your renewal or upgrade request.
- Letters from your college preparation program: Contact your Educator Preparation Program to have them submit the letter to our office at contact.tspc@oregon.gov

C: The Restricted Teaching License requires evidence of progress in your teacher prep program to reissue. Please review your license advice you received with your first Restricted Teaching License for details.

D: Renewing the Teacher Leader License requires submission of the Teacher Leader Portfolio to demonstrate the continuing leadership activities.

Upgrading from the Preliminary to the Professional Teaching License?

You will select "Submit New Application" in eLicensing to apply and must submit a PEER form to demonstrate teaching experience and evidence of completion of an approved Advanced Program. Please see additional information on the Upgrading to Professional webpage.
