BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION leacher Standards & 1 **Practices Commission** 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS 4 AND FINAL ORDER OF 5 6 7) SURRENDER, SUSPENSION Educator License of) AND PROBATION BETH LEE DEVOGELE 8 On October 22, 2018, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 9 (Commission) received a report from the Gladstone Police Department indicating Beth DeVogele (DeVogele) may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty and/or gross 10 11 unfitness, by engaging in unwanted, offensive physical contact with multiple students at 12 the Kraxberger Middle School. After review of the matters alleged, DeVogele and the Commission agree that 13 14 their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, the acceptance of DeVogele's surrendered Oregon educator 15 license, the imposition of a one year suspension, and a period of probation upon 16 17 reinstatement of DeVogele's Oregon educator license. This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 18 sanction to be imposed. DeVogele stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in 19 20 the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law 21 set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, DeVogele waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 22 23 By signing below, DeVogele acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to 24 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and 25 finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this 26 Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Surrender, Suspension and Probation 27 (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document 28 and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and 29 Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. 30 If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then 31 neither DeVogele nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully 32 read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, 33 without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to 34 issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or 35

representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

- 1. The Commission has licensed DeVogele since July 8, 1977. DeVogele's Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in Substitute Any Specialty (PP-12), is valid from June 15, 2018 through July 4, 2021. During all relevant times, DeVogele was employed by the Gladstone School District (GSD) as a substitute teacher at Kraxberger Middle School.
- 2. On October 22, 2018, the Commission received a report from the Gladstone Police Department indicating that on October 4, 2018, DeVogele had engaged in unwanted, offensive physical contact with multiple students while employed as an educator at the Kraxberger Middle School. Investigation determined that district staff received reports of DeVogele yelling at students, aggressively and physically directing students, and that DeVogele had thrown a water bottle at a student in her classroom, missing the student and hitting another student's chair. GSD had you removed from their substitute teacher list for violation of district policies related to your conduct.
- 3. On December 24, 2018, criminal charges were filed in the Clackamas County Circuit Court. On April 29, 2019, you plead guilty to one count of Harassment, ORS 166.065(3), a class B misdemeanor. As part of your plea agreement you agreed to surrender your teaching license until July 1, 2020.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The conduct described in section two (2) above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0020(2)(d) (Skill in the supervision of students), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(a) (Establishing and maintaining classroom management that is conducive to learning), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b) (Skill in communicating with administrators, students, staff, parents, and other patrons); and 584-020-0040(4)(d)(Unreasonable physical force against students, fellow employees, or visitors to the school, except as permitted under ORS 339.250).

The conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-010(5) (Use professional judgement). The conduct described in section three above also constitute gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) (Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty plea, no contest plea or any other means).

The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

ORDER

The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, and based thereon, accepts the surrender of Beth Lee DeVogele's Oregon educator license and imposes a one (1) year suspension upon Beth Lee DeVogele's Oregon educator license as follows:

Beth Lee DeVogele's Oregon educator license is hereby suspended for one (1) year following the adoption of this order.

Furthermore, the Commission imposes a two (2) year period of probation upon DeVogele to commence upon reinstatement of her Oregon educator license and subject to the following terms and conditions of probation:

1	 DeVogele shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical
2	Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules
3	Chapter 584, Division 020.

5	Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for
6	the Commission to revoke DeVogele's Oregon educator license or otherwise impose
7	discipline, after first providing DeVogele with notice and opportunity for hearing
