4	disqualifying for consideration of TSPC/State of Oregon teacher licensure.

This conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) (<i>Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty plea, no contest plea or any other means); and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (<i>Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even in the absence of a conviction</i>).</i>
