REICHENBACH 8 9 10 On September 6, 2023, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 11 (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Timothy J. Reichenbach, 12 (Reichenbach) in which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty and 13 or Gross Unfitness. The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified 14 Mail Receipt 9589 0710 5270 0844 8660 36 to the address on file with the Commission. 15 The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima 16 facie case. The Notice was confirmed as received by Reichenbach's attorney, Noah 17 Barish. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated September 6, 2023, and signed by 18 Melissa Goff, Executive Director, stated: 19 20 "IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED 21 22 UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, 23 24 WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, OR IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT 25 APPEAR AT HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF 26 27 DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF 28 YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE." 29 30 Per direction by Reichenbach's attorney, Noah Barish, Reichenbach has requested that this matter be resolved via a Default Order. The Commission, therefore, 31 32 finds Reichenbach to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions 33 of law, and final order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this 34 matter. 35 FINDING OF FACT 36 1. The Commission has licensed Reichenbach since August 31, 2018. Reichenbach 37 currently holds a Preliminary Teaching License with endorsements in Social Studies 38 (PK-12) and Business and Management Marketing (CTE) (PK-12). The license was

1		issued on December 20, 2021 and expires on December 19, 2024. During all relevant
2		times, Reichenbach was employed by the Hillsboro High School (HSD).
3		
4	2.	On May 25, 2022, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC) received
5		information from Oregon's Department of Human Services (DHS) that Reichenbach
6		had allegedly sexually abused a seventeen (17) year-old female Hillsboro High School
7		(HHS) identified as IH during the 2021-2022 school year. On May 31, 2022 TSPC
8		received a School District Misconduct Report from the HSD indicating Reichenbach
9		had been placed on administrative leave after receiving information from DHS about
0		the sexual abuse allegations.

12	3.	Investigation by DHS and the Hillsboro Police Department (HPD) determined the
13		following:
14		· On May 24, 2022 the HPD received information from DHS regarding
16		allegation of possible sex abuse of IH, a seventeen (17) year old female, by
17		Reichenbach.
8		<ul> <li>On May 26, 2022, DHS received another report of alleged sexual abuse</li> </ul>
9		involving Reichenbach and another of IH's siblings.
20		<ul> <li>IH reported to investigators that Reichenbach had sexually abused her. The</li> </ul>
21		abuse included sending her sexually inappropriate photos and videos, kissing
22		her, touching her breasts and genitals, having her masturbate Reichenbach,
23		and Reichenbach attempting to have sexual intercourse with her.

2.5		<ul> <li>HSD placed Reichenbach on administrative leave pending an investigation on</li> </ul>

80	4.	Commission Investigative staff made multiple requests for Reichenbach to
31		participate in an interview related to this matter. On June 12, 2023, Commission
2		Investigative staff spoke with Reichenbach's attorney Noah Barish, who reported

1	that Reichenbach would be declining to interview with TSPC and would be invoking
2	his 5 <sup>th</sup> Amendment right.
3	
4	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
5	The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS
6	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1)
7	(Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR
8	584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using
9	district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it
10	incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(b) (Refrain from exploiting professional
11	relationships with any student for personal gain, or in support of persons or issues),
12	OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(A) (Not demonstrating or expressing professionally
13	inappropriate interest in a student's personal life), and OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D)
14	(Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and conversations
15	at all times).
16	
17	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based
18	upon ORS 342.175.
19	FINAL ORDER
20	The Commission hereby revokes Reichenbach's Oregon teaching license and
21	imposes a period of probation of three (3) years if reinstatement is granted.
22	Additionally, the Commission imposes a condition that a psychosexual evaluation from
23	an approved provider be required before reinstatement is considered.
