8	On December 27, 2021, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission			
9	(Commission) staff reviewed licensure information for Zachary A. Brandsen (Brandsen)			
10	and learned Brandsen may have engaged in professional misconduct. Specifically, there			
11	was information indicating Brandsen may have been teaching for extended periods			
12	without a valid Oregon teaching license.			
13	After review of the matters alleged, Brandsen and the Commission agree that			
14	their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a			
15	stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand.			
16	This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the			
17	sanction to be imposed. Brandsen stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in			
18	the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law			
19	set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Brandsen waives the right to a hearing			
20	to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.			
21	By signing below, Brandsen acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to			
22	the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to a hearing to contest the			
23	findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally			
24	waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of			
25	Facts and Final Order of Public Rep	rimand (Stip	ulation and Final Order); (ii) this	
26	Stipulation and Final Order is a pub	lic document	and disclosed to the public upon	
27	request by the Commission; (iii) this	Stipulation	and Final Order is contingent upon and	
28	subject to approval and adoption by	the Commis	sion. If the Commission does not	
29	approve and adopt this Stipulation a	and Final Ord	ler, then neither Brandsen nor the	
30	Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and			
31	Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or			
32	duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of			
33	the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has			
34	been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has			
35	consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully			

advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

The Commission has licensed Brandsen since August 4, 2016. Bransen holds a
Charter School Registry with an endorsement in Teacher (PK-12), valid from
September 14, 2023, through January 5, 2027. Brandsen also holds a Preliminary
Teaching License with an endorsement in Social Studies (PK-12), valid from
March 18, 2024, through January 5, 2028. During all relevant times, Brandsen
was employed by the Pendleton School District (PSD).

 On March 22, 2023, the Commission received information from an internal referral indicating Brandsen may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty. Specifically, it was reported Brandsen was teaching without a valid Oregon teaching license since 2021.

3. Investigation determined that Brandsen has been employed as a teacher by the Pendleton School district since the 2015-16 school year. The Commission issued Brandsen a Restricted Substitute Teaching License, valid from August 3, 2016, through June 29, 2017, and then later issued him a Restricted Teaching License, valid from October 21, 2016, through June 29, 2017. The Commission issued Brandsen a second Restricted Teaching License, valid from February 6, 2019, through June 30, 2020. The Commission issued Brandsen a third Restricted Teaching License, valid from July 30, 2020, through June 30, 2021. In October 2021, March 2022, and October 2022, Brandsen made application for licensure but did not meet the requirements for a Preliminary Teaching License. For the entire 2017-18 and 2021-22 school years, Brandsen taught without a valid Oregon teaching license. For extended periods during the 2018-19 and 2022-23 school years, Brandsen taught without a valid Oregon teaching license.

18	appropriate for the assignment while working as a public school, education service			
19	district or charter school employee); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (Working without a			
20	license)			
21	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon			
22	ORS 342.175.

25	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and			
26	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Zachary A.			
27	Brandsen's Oregon educator license.
