LOCEY 7 8 On June 6, 2023, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 9 (Commission) received a report from the Morrow County School District (District) 10 indicating Tiffany M. Locey (Locey) may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty 11 and/or gross unfitness. Specifically, District reported Locey failed to supervise students 12 traveling to and from a track meet; misrepresented her actions to staff; and allowed her 13 absence to be improperly recorded. 14 After review of the matters alleged, Locey and the Commission agree that their 15 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 16 certain facts and the imposition of a thirty (30) day suspension. 17 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 18 sanction to be imposed. Locey stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the 19 Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set 20 forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Locey waives the right to a hearing to 21 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 22 By signing below, Locey acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 23 following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to contest 24 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 25 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 26 Facts and Final Order of Suspension (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation 27 and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the 28 Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to 29 approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 30 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Locey nor the Commission are 31 bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and 32 understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into 33 this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated 34 Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has been made to 35 induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has consulted with an

attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with

regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior

STIPULATION OF FACTS

1. The Commission has licensed Locey since December 15, 2019. Locey holds a Preliminary Teaching License with endorsements in Physical Education (PK-12) and Health (PK-12) valid from January 14, 2025, through January 13, 2028. Locey also holds a License of Conditional Assignment (LCA) with an endorsement in Elementary - Multiple Subjects (PK-12) valid from December 2, 2024, through June 30, 2025. During all relevant times, Locey was employed by the Morrow County School District (MCSD).

2. On June 6, 2023, the Commission received a School District Misconduct Report from the MCSD indicating Locey may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty. Specifically, the MCSD reported Locey failed to supervise students traveling to and from a track meet; misrepresented her actions to staff; and allowed her absence to be recorded as coaching rather than having it reflect the appropriate leave for attending a funeral.

3. Investigation found a student's mother passed and the funeral was scheduled to occur in the Portland area on a school day, April 27, 2023. Locey was close to the student and supported the student when the student was having difficult family circumstances. Locey planned to travel to the funeral with the student, Locey's son, and two other students. The students were all high-school aged.

30 31 4. Investigation found that on April 27, 2023, a school day, the Irrigon Junior/Senior High School track team was scheduled to travel by bus to Milton-Freewater for a track meet. On April 27, 2023, Locey was on campus at the start of the school day and was present when the track team and an assistant coach boarded a bus for the meet. Locey briefly got on the bus and then exited the bus. The bus departed for the meet at approximately 9:30 AM.

5. Investigation found that on April 27, 2023, shortly after the bus with the track team and assistant coach departed the campus, Locey left campus, picked up students in

her personal automobile and began traveling to the Portland area to attend the funeral. As required by district policy, Locey failed to meet the requirements for transporting students in her personal vehicle. At approximately 9:50 AM, a parent of a student on the track team texted Locey about her not being on the bus.

Approximately ten (10) to fifteen (15) minutes later, the same parent contacted the school about this. A district staff member checked the records and saw Locey's entry for work hours that day annotated as of a full day of coaching. The staff member texted Locey asking if Locey was on the bus. Locey responded by text, writing she recently found out about a funeral and forgot to tell staff she would not be on the bus. The Irrigon Junior/Senior High School principal texted Locey to see if she was on the bus. Locey responded by text, writing she was not on the bus, and she was driving to La Grande to attend the funeral.

6. Investigation found that after the text exchange with staff, Locey arranged for some of the students to continue traveling to the funeral in another vehicle with another person traveling to the Portland area to attend the funeral. Locey and a student, who was no longer going to attend the funeral, returned to Irrigon and Locey dropped the student off at the student's residence. Locey then drove to Milton-Freewater, arriving at approximately 1:00 PM to coach the track team.

7. Investigation found that at approximately 1:15 PM, Locey received a text from the Irrigon High School principal about parents concerned the track team was unsupervised. Locey responded by text that she was no longer going to attend the funeral, and she would ride the bus home with the students. After the track meet ended, the team and assistant coach got on the bus and departed, stopped for a team dinner, and arrived in Irrigon at approximately 7:00PM. Locey did not ride on the bus or attend the team dinner, and instead she proceeded in her personal automobile directly from Milton-Freewater to her residence.

8. Investigation found that on May 12, 2023, during the MCSD's third party investigation, Locey admitted to not being honest in her first interview with an investigator. Locey admitted that her intention on April 27, 2023, was to attend the funeral and only after communicating with staff and parents did she decide to forego the funeral and attend the track meet.
