## 1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 Educator License of ) FINAL ORDER OF 5 ) PUBLIC REPRIMAND NAOMI P. RICH 6 7 8 9 On July 13, 2023, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 10 (Commission) received a misconduct report from the Nyssa School District (NSD), 11 alleging possible professional misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Naomi P. 12 Rich (Rich). 13 After review of the matters alleged, Rich and the Commission agree that their 14 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 15 certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand on Rich's teaching license. 16 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 17 sanction to be imposed. Rich stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the 18 Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Rich waives the right to a hearing to 19 20 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 21 By signing below, Rich acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 22 following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to contest 23 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 24 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 25 Facts and Final Order of Revocation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation 26 and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the 27 Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to 28 approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 29 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Rich nor the Commission are bound 30 by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and 31 understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into 32 this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated 33 Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has consulted with an 34

attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with

regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior

1 to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated 2 Final Order below. 3 4 STIPULATION OF FACTS 5 6 1. The Commission has licensed Rich since July 1, 2022. Rich holds a Restricted 7 Substitute Teaching License with an endorsement in Substitute (PK-12) which 8 was issued on July 1, 2022 and expires on June 30, 2025. During all relevant 9 times, Rich was employed by the Nyssa School District (NSD). 10 11 2. On July 13, 2023, TSPC received a School District Misconduct Report from Ryan Hawkins, the Assistant Superintendent of the NSD regarding Rich, a substitute 12 13 teacher/bus driver. The report alleged that the NSD was contacted by the Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS) on July 13, 2023, advising that DHS had 14 removed Rich's children from her home as a result of Rich failing to report that 15 16 her minor-aged daughter had been sexually abused. 17 3. According to NSD and DHS records as well as TSPC's investigation, the following 18 19 was substantiated: Rich has two biological daughters with her ex-husband, Todd Harden 20 (Harden). Both daughters are minors. 21 22 On June 23, 2023, the court awarded temporary custody of both daughters to Harden. 23 24 The decision for the change in custody was the result of Rich allowing one of 25 her daughters to be around a 13 year-old boy, LF. 26 LF sexually assaulted one of Rich's daughters on the May 13, 2023. LF was 27 criminally charged with Attempted Sexual Abuse in the 1st degree. • Rich became aware of the assault on the evening of May 13, 2023. 28 On May 14, 2023, Rich spoke to her counselor and told them about the 29 assault. She believed that the counselor would report the assault. 30 After leaving the counselor's office, Rich went to LF's residence and 31 confronted him about the assault. 32

1 LF admitted the assault. 2 On May 16, 2023, Rich's counselor reported the assault to authorities. 3 • On June 2, 2023, Rich took the daughter who had been assaulted by LF to 4 LF's residence for a play date with LF's sister. 5 On an unknown date in June, 2023 (after the assault) LF's mother, drove 6 Rich's daughter and a few other children to the library with LF sitting in the 7 front seat. 8 On June 26, 2023, Harden is granted temporary custody of both daughters 9 due to Rich allowing the daughters to be around LF after the sexual assault 10 had occurred. 11 Rich did not notify law enforcement of the assault through traditional means. 12 On May 14, 2023, Rich reported the assault to her ex-husband. Rich's ex-13 husband is the father of the daughter who was a victim of LF's assault. The 14 father is a police officer at the Ontario Police Department. Rich did not report the assault to DHS. 15 During Rich's interview with TSPC investigative staff on September 19, 2024, 16 Rich reported that she was "not in a good mental state" after the assault and 17 stated that she believed that her counselor was going to report the assault to 18 19 the authorities. 20 21 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 3/18/25 Date 3/18/25 Naomi P. Rich 23 24 25 Cristina Edgar, Deputy Director 26 27 Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 28 29 CONCLUSION OF LAW 30 The conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of 31 duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates 32 OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using

1	district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-020-
2	0040(4)(s)(Failing to report child abuse pursuant to ORS 419B.010).

5	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
6	ORS 342.175.

8	ORDER
9	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
10	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand upon Naomi P.
11	Rich's Oregon educator license.
