8	On September 11, 2023, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission			
10	(Commission) received a School District Misconduct Report from Portland Public			
11	Schools (PPS), alleging possible professional misconduct on the part of licensed			
12	educator, Ezra R. Whitman (Whitman).			
13	After review of the matters alleged, Whitman and the Commission agree that			
14	their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a			
15	stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand on Whitman's			
16	teaching license.			
17	This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the			
18	sanction to be imposed. Whitman stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in			
19	the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law	١.		
20	set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Whitman waives the right to a hearing			
21	to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.			
22	By signing below, Whitman acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to	0		
23	the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest	t		
24	the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally			
25	waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of			
26	Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this			
27	Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon			
28	request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and	d		
29	subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not			
30	approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Whitman nor the			
31	Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and			
32	Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or			
33	duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry	of		
34	the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has			
35	been made to juduce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has

consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully

advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an 1 2 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of 3 the Stipulated Final Order below. 4 5 STIPULATION OF FACTS 6 7 1. The Commission has licensed Whitman since January 15, 2021. Whitman 8 currently holds a Professional Teaching License with endorsements for 9 English Language Arts (PK-12) and Health (PK-12) which was issued on February 14, 2023 and expires on November 3, 2028 and a Principal 10 License issued on January 5, 2023 and expires on November 3, 2026. 11 During all relevant times, Whitman was employed by the Portland Public 12 13 Schools (PPS). 14 2. On September 11, 2023, TSPC received a School District Misconduct 15 16 Report from PPS. The report alleged that Whitman, a teacher at Roosevelt 17 High School (RHS) in the PPS, had provided inaccurate information on 18 background questions on his PPS employment application. 19 3. An investigation into this matter by the Commission and PPS determined 20 the following: 21 22 • On or about August 29, 2023, PPS conducted a background check 23 on Whitman, who had applied for a Vice Principal position at 24 McDaniel High School in the PPS. 25 A PPS investigator discovered as part of the background check, that 26 Whitman has previously been employed as a Licensed Practical 27 Nurse in Oregon from 2008-2015. 28 The PPS investigator determined that Whitman had voluntarily 29 30 surrendered his nursing license in September of 2015. The PPS investigator found records documenting that Whitman had 31 been investigated by the Oregon Nursing Board for tampering with 32

1	narcotic packaging and replacing narcotic tablets with non-narcotic
2	tablets.
3	 Additionally, the PPS investigator uncovered Oregon Nursing Board
4	records that noted that Whitman had admitted to approximately six
5	(6) documented instances of medication administration errors that
6	had occurred between October 2014 and June of 2015.
7	PPS investigation also determined that Whitman had a previous
8	DUI/Reckless Driving charge from 2012.
9	None of the above listed incidents had been noted on numerous
10	employment applications Whitman submitted to PPS.
11	Whitman replied "no" to the following TSPC character questions on
12	the various licensure applications he had submitted to TSPC on
13	April 4, 2017, October 15, 2017, January 6, 2023, September 18,
14	2022, and January 6, 2023. The character questions Whitman
15	replied "no" to on the TSPC character questions were:
16	
17	3. Have you ever been investigated by an employer or state agency for alleged
18	physical or sexual abuse? Have you ever been placed on leave by your employe
19	for alleged misconduct of any type?
20	
21	6. Have you ever surrendered a professional license of any kid before its
22	expiration date?
23	
24	7. Have you ever been disciplined by ay public agency responsible for licensure
25	of any kind, including but not limited to educational licensure, other than
26	discipline from the Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission?
27	
28	 TSPC investigative staff interviewed Whitman on January 22, 2025.
29	 Whitman signed a Separation Agreement with PPS on March 3, 2024.

0	duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c) Falsification of
1	any document or knowing misrepresentation directly related to licensure,
12	employment, or professional duties; OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it
13	incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), and OAR 584-
4	020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations).

16	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
17	ORS 342.175.
8	ORDER
19	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
20	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand upon Ezra R.
21	Whitman's Oregon educator license.
