On May 13, 2024, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a report from the Logos Public Charter School, which is sponsored by the Medford School District (District), alleging Robin E. Biggs-Holden (Biggs-Holden) violated professional standards by failing to provide 60 days' written notice of resignation as required by contract and Oregon state law ORS 342.553(1).

After review of the matters alleged, Biggs-Holden and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, and the imposition of a Public Reprimand.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Biggs-Holden stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Biggs-Holden waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

By signing below, Biggs-Holden acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Biggs-Holden nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an

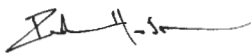
1 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of
2 the Stipulated Final Order below.

4 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

- 5 1. The Commission has licensed Robin E. Biggs-Holden since June 25, 2020.
6 Biggs-Holden holds a Professional Teaching License, with an endorsement in Art
7 (PK-12), is valid from September 1, 2021, through May 1, 2027. During all
8 relevant times, Biggs-Holden was employed by the Logos Public Charter School
9 (LPCS).

- 11 2. On May 13, 2024, the Commission received a School District Misconduct Report
12 from the LPCS alleging Biggs-Holden violated professional standards by failing to
13 provide 60 days' written notice of resignation as required by contract and Oregon
14 state law ORS 342.553(1).

- 16 3. Investigation found that on September 11, 2023, Biggs-Holden signed an
17 acknowledgement of the LPCS's Handbook and at Will Employment. On September
18 29, 2023, Biggs-Holden signed an Acceptance of Offer with the LPCS for limited and
19 specified employment for the 2023-24 school year. On September 6, 2023, students
20 began attending classes for the 2023-24 school year which ended on June 6, 2024. On
21 May 5, 2024, Biggs-Holden mailed the district a letter informing them of her
22 impending move out of state and that she had arranged a substitute teacher to fill in
23 for her for the remainder of the 2023-24 school year. On May 6, 2024, Biggs-Holden
24 sent the school book keeper a courtesy reminder regarding several outstanding tasks.
25 On May 6, 2024, the school notified Biggs-Holden that time off requests needed to be
26 reviewed and approved by her supervisor; that the amount of her available time off
27 would not cover five (5) weeks of classes; that Biggs-Holden was expected to return to
28 her class on May 9, 2024; and a breach of contract could result in a report to the
29 Commission for her failing to provide adequate written notice of her resignation. On
30 May 7, 2024, Biggs-Holden's site supervisor emailed Biggs-Holden expressing
31 understanding of her family's relocation and she would be missed. The school
32 received an out-of-office response from Biggs-Holden's email which read that she
33 would be away from May 6, 2024, through June 6, 2024. Biggs-Holden did fulfill

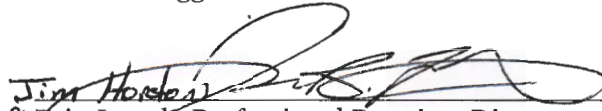
1 limited work responsibilities on May 6, 9, and 10, 2024. Biggs-Holden did not return
2 to LPCS for the remainder of the 2023-24 school year.

15 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

16 Robin E. Biggs-Holden's conduct, as described above, constitutes gross neglect of
17 duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR
18 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (*Using*
19 *district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations*); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(j)
20 (*Resignation from a contract in violation of ORS 342.553*).

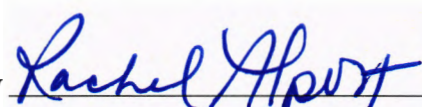
21 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
22 ORS 342.175.

24 **ORDER**

25 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
26 conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand upon Robin E.
27 Biggs-Holden's Oregon educator license.
