Carlson) REPRIMAND AND PROBATION 6 7 8 9 10 On December 18, 2024, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 11 (Commission) received a School District Misconduct Report from the Hermiston School 12 District (HSD). The report alleged possible professional misconduct on the part of 13 licensed educator, Karly K. Carlson (Carlson). 14 After review of the matters alleged, Carlson and the Commission agree that their 15 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 16 certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand of her Oregon Educator License 17 and a period of probation. 18 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 19 sanction to be imposed. Carlson stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the 20 Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set 21 forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Carlson waives the right to a hearing to 22 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 23 By signing below, Carlson acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 24 the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to 25 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and 26 finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this 27 Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand and Probation (Stipulation and 28 Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to 29 the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is 30 contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the 31 Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither 32 Carlson nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this 33 Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without 34 any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance 35 and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or

representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and

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1 (vii) she has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and 2 has been fully advised with regard to her rights thereto or waives any and all rights to 3 consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and 4 issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. 5 6 STIPULATION OF FACTS 7 1. The Commission has licensed Carlson since April 6, 2006. Carlson holds a 8 Preliminary Teaching License with endorsements in Special Education: 9 Generalist (PreK-12) which was issued on February 28, 2025, and expires on February 27, 2028. During all relevant times, Carlson was employed by the 10 11 Hermiston School District (HSD). Carlson worked at the HSD for a total 14 years 12 as both a SPED Teacher and Educational Assistant and had no prior disciplinary 13 issues. 14 15 2. On December 18, 2024, the Commission received a School District Misconduct 16 report from the HSD. The report alleged that Carlson, a licensed Oregon educator 17 and a SPED teacher at Hermiston Elementary School (HES) engaged in 18 professional misconduct. Specifically, the report alleges that Carlson was under 19 the influence of alcohol, while at work at HES when students were present. 20 21 3. Investigation by HSD and TSPC determined the following: 22 23 On the morning of December 5, 2024, Carlson showed up to work at 24 approximately 7:30 a.m. Shortly after 9:00 a.m., multiple staff reported to 25 the HES Principal that Carlson appeared to be under the influence of alcohol 26 at work. 27 The HSD School Resource Officer (SRO), a Hermiston Police Officer, was 28 contacted and made contact with Carlson. The SRO conducted field sobriety tests on Carlson and determined that she 29 30 was under the influence of alcohol. 31 Carlson admitted to the SRO and HSD administration that she had been 32 drinking vodka the previous night. 33 Carlson was transported to have a breathalyzer (BAC) done, and while in the

waiting room of the lobby Carlson told HES Principal Josh Browning

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1 (Browning) that she was "certain" that the test would show she was under the 2 influence of alcohol. 3 Carlson then then admitted to Principal Browning that she "needed help" and told him that she was "sorry." The results of the BAC test confirmed alcohol consumption at a blood alcohol 5 6 content of 0.202 at 10:48 a.m. The HES immediately placed Carlson on administrative leave. Carlson, on her own initiative, immediately sought and entered into 8 9 treatment on December 10, 2024. She successfully completed inpatient and intensive outpatient programs and has been fully compliant with her recovery 10 11 plan. 12 Carlson resigned her employment effective June 12, 2025 pursuant to a 13 Separation Agreement. 14 15 16 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 07/25/2025 17 Karly K. Carlson 18 Date 19 20 21 Cristina Edgar, Profession Practices Director Date 22 Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 23 24 CONCLUSION OF LAW 25 The conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(g) (Appearing on duty or at 26 any district-sponsored activity while under the influence of alcohol, marijuana or any 27 controlled substance); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-28 0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful 29 30 and reasonable rules and regulations). 31

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1	ORDER
2	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
3	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a public reprimand and a three (3) year
4	period of probation. The period of probation will become effective on the date of adoption of
5	this stipulated order. The period of probation is subject to the following conditions:
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8	1. Carlson shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance
9	of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division
10	020.
