On December 19, 2024, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a School District Misconduct Report from the West Linn–Wilsonville School District (WWSD). The report alleged possible professional misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Bryn D. Card (Card).

After review of the matters alleged, Card and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand of his Oregon Educator License.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Card stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Card waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

By signing below, Card acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Suspension and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Card nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully

1 advised with regard to her rights thereto or waives any and all rights to consult with an
2 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of
3 the Stipulated Final Order below.

5 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

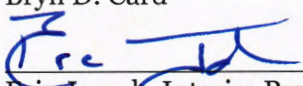
- 6
7 1. The Commission has licensed Card since April 8, 2015. Card currently holds
8 a Preliminary Teaching License with an endorsement for Special Education
9 Generalist (PK-12) which was issued on November 4, 2025, and expires on
10 November 3, 2028. During all relevant times Card was employed by the
11 West Linn-Wilsonville School District (WWSD) as a teacher and varsity
12 baseball coach.

14 2. On December 19, 2024, TSPC received a School District Misconduct report
15 from the WWSD alleging that Card misused funds belonging to the
16 Diamond Club, a booster organization for the Wilsonville Hight School
17 Baseball team.
- 18
19 3. An investigation into this matter determined the following:
- 20
- 21 • In 2017, the West Linn-Wilsonville Diamond Club was informally
22 founded by coaches and parents of players on the Wilsonville School
23 Varsity Baseball team as a Booster Club.
 - 24 • On November 2, 2017, the Diamond Club was registered as a
25 Domestic Non-Profit.
 - 26 • In May of 2022, with permission and approval from his Athletic
27 Director and on behalf of the Diamond Club, Card had the Diamond
28 Club waive a tournament fee of \$917.00 for his own private youth
29 team that developed talent for the high school team.
 - 30 • Also in 2022, with permission and approval from his Athletic
31 Director and on behalf of the Diamond Club, Card had the Diamond
32 Club accept a credit of \$9,715.00 for tournament fees for subletting

1 WWSD fields to the West Coast Premier League.

- 2 • In May of 2024, WWSD administration was notified by a concerned
3 parent who had recently become involved in managing the club's
4 finances that there had been inappropriate expenditures made by
5 Card.
- 6 • The WWSD audited the club's finances from the window of August 2021
7 and July 2024.
- 8 • The WWSD audit documented the following questionable charges on
9 the Diamond Club's credit card:
 - 10 ○ A Kindle Unlimited monthly subscription in Card's name.
 - 11 ○ An Amazon Music monthly Subscription in Card's name.
 - 12 ○ An Airbnb charge charges with no documentation or receipt.
 - 13 ○ A miscellaneous Amazon purchase with no documentation or
14 receipts.
 - 15
- 16
- 17 • These purchases totaled approximately \$300. When these purchases were
18 identified as being made on the Diamond Club credit card, Card indicated
19 he had accidentally used the Diamond Club card for the amounts rather
20 than his personal card and immediately reimbursed the Diamond Club for
21 the full amount of the purchases.
- 22 • The WWSD issued Card a Letter of Reprimand for "failure to adhere
23 to district policies GBC-Staff Ethics and for failure to demonstrate
24 good judgement and uphold professional standards" for this
25 incident.
- 26 • The Oregon Department of Justice (DOJ) was notified that Card
27 might be using Diamond Club funds for activities other than for the
28 club.
- 29 • The DOJ Charitable Activities Section investigated Card and alleged
30 that he operated the Diamond Club in violation of common law
31 fiduciary duties, including but not limited to "failing to observe

1 corporate formalities” and “failing to maintain adequate accounting
2 or other corporate records.” (ORS 65.771). On June 17, 2025, Card
3 and the DOJ entered into an Assurance of Voluntary Compliance that
4 is not considered an admission of a violation for any purpose. As part
5 of the Assurance of Voluntary Compliance agreement, Card agreed to
6 refrain from serving in a fiduciary capacity for any charitable or
7 nonprofit organization for a period of five (5) years from the date of
8 the agreement.

23 *incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-*
24 *0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and*
25 *OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a)(Maintain*
26 *the dignity of the profession by respecting and obeying the law, exemplifying*
27 *personal integrity and honesty).*

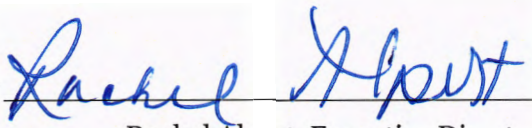
