On February 11, 2024, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a School District Misconduct Report from the Beaverton School District (BSD). The report indicated that Evan P. Robbins (Robbins) may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness.

After review of the matters alleged, Robbins and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, and the revocation of Robbins' Oregon educator license.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Robbins stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact, and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Robbins waives the right to a notice of hearing, and the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

By signing below, Robbins acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Surrender and Revocation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Robbins nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. 1 entering into this stipulation, Robbins waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of
2 fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

3 4 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

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6 1) The Commission has licensed Robbins since May 27, 2021. Robbins currently holds a
7 Preliminary School Social Worker License with an endorsement for School Social
8 Worker (PK-12), which was issued on July 6, 2024, and expires on July 5, 2027.
9 During all relevant times, Robbins was employed by the Beaverton School District
10 (BSD).

12 2) On February 11, 2024, the Commission received a School District Misconduct Report
13 from the BSD. The report alleged that Robbins was suspected of having engaged in
14 sexual conduct with an unidentified 18-year-old student at the International School
15 of Beaverton in the BSD.

17 Also on February 11, 2024, the Commission received a Department of Human
18 Services (DHS) report on Robbins alleging the same behavior listed above. The DHS
19 referral identified the unidentified student as "Student A" who was a former student
20 of Robbins.

22 3) Investigation determined the following:

- 23
- 24 • Robbins had inappropriate in-person contact with Student A, outside of
 - 25 school, off work hours on multiple occasions in the Spring of 2024.
 - 26 • Student A was approximately 18 years of age during these off-site in-
 - 27 person meetings but was still a student (senior) at Robbins' school.
 - 28 • On or about June 30, 2024, Student A was seen walking with Robbins
 - 29 through his neighborhood in Milwaukie, Oregon.
 - 30 • Robbins engaged in inappropriate and unauthorized text messaging with
 - 31 Student A from approximately April of 2024 to September of 2024.

- Robbins engaged in numerous and frequent off-duty phone calls with Student A from April of 2024 to December of 2024.
- The duration of the calls between Robbins and Student A ranged from 1 minute to 310 minutes.
- The calls and texts were shared between Robbins personal cell phone and Student A's personal cell phone.
- The allegations of sexual conduct were not founded.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1) (Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0020(2)(d) (Skill in the supervision of students), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and conversations at all times).

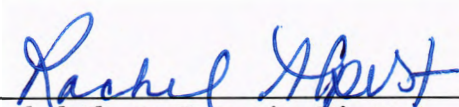
The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
