On February 24 and 25, 2025, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received information from the Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS) reporting that Kyle W. Hansen (Hansen) was alleged to have touched students inappropriately, made inappropriate comments to students, and encroached into students' personal space.

After review of the matters alleged, Hansen and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, and the Surrender and Revocation of Hansen's Oregon educator license.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Hansen stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact, and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Hansen waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

By signing below, Hansen acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Surrender of Licensure and Revocation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Hansen nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and

entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. In entering into this stipulation, Hansen waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

1. The Commission has licensed Kyle W. Hansen since January 29, 2024. Hansen held an Emergency Teaching License, with an endorsement in Business: Generalist (PK-12), valid from August 30, 2024, through June 30, 2025. During all relevant times, Hansen was employed by the North Douglas School District (NDSD).
2. On February 24 and 26, 2025, the Commission received reports from the Oregon Department of Human Services containing allegations that while Hansen was teaching at NDHS, Hansen touched students’ backs, hair, necks, arms and legs; made inappropriate comments to students, some of which were sexual in nature; and encroached into students’ personal space.
3. Investigation found that on unspecified dates during the 2023-24 and 2024-25 school years, Hansen violated teacher/student boundaries and had inappropriate physical contact with female several students at NDHS which included the following:
 - Unsolicited touches to the students on their legs, backs, necks, hair, ears, and mouths.
 - Unsolicited frontal, rear and side hugs to the students.
 - Drank from the students’ water bottles without permission.
 - Followed the students on social media.
 - Gave an unsolicited 10-15 second massage to a student’s neck which made the student uncomfortable.
 - Engaged in horseplay with students and on several occasions, placed students in headlocks.

4. Investigation found that on February 13, 2025, Hansen resigned from his teaching position with the NDSD.

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12 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

13 Kyle W. Hansen's conduct in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of duty in
14 violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-
15 0010(1) (*Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual*), OAR
16 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), and OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b) (*Skill in*
17 *communicating with administrators, students, staff, parents, and other patrons*); OAR 584-
18 020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (*Honoring appropriate adult*
19 *boundaries with students in conduct and conversations at all times*).

20 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
21 342.175.

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23 **ORDER**

24 The Commission adopts the above Stipulation of Facts, and hereby accepts the
25 Surrender of Kyle W. Hansen's Oregon Educator License and imposes a Revocation upon his
26 license and an agreement that Hansen shall not reapply for a license in the future.
