On August 21, 2025, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a School District Misconduct Report from the Lincoln County School District (LCSD). The report indicated that Isaac J. Bass (Bass) may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness.

After review of the matters alleged, Bass and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, and the revocation of Bass's Oregon educator license.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Bass stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact, and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Bass waives the right to a notice of hearing, and the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

By signing below, Bass acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Surrender and Revocation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Bass nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. In

1 entering into this stipulation, Bass waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact,
2 conclusions of law and order set forth below.

3 4 **STIPULATION OF FACTS**

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6 1) The Commission has licensed Bass since August 8, 2003. Bass currently holds a
7 Professional Teaching License with an endorsement for Advanced Mathematics (PK-
8 12), Foundational Mathematics (PK-12), and Legacy Middle Level (PK-12). The
9 license was issued on October 25, 2023 and expires on December 6, 2028. During all
10 relevant times, Bass was employed by the Lincoln County School District (LCSD).

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12 2) On August 21, 2025, the Commission received a School District Misconduct Report
13 from the LCSD. On August 21, 2025, a second School District Misconduct Report
14 was received from the Eugene School District 4J (E4J). The reports allege that Bass,
15 a licensed educator, engaged in professional misconduct. Specifically, the reports
16 alleges that Bass engaged in a inappropriate romantic relationship with a minor
17 aged female Churchill High School (CHS) student (Student A), in 2003-04. At the
18 time of the relationship with Student A, Bass was 26 years old and Student A was 17.

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20 3) Investigation by TSPC and The Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS/OTIS)
21 determined the following:

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- 23 • Student A was a student at CHS in Eugene, Oregon during the 2003-2004
 - 24 school year.
 - 25 • Bass was employed as a math teacher at CHS during the 2003-2004 school
 - 26 year.
 - 27 • During the 2003-2004 school year, Student A became Bass' student teaching
 - 28 assistant.
 - 29 • During the 2003-2004 school year, Bass and Student A began spending time
 - 30 together both at school and outside of school.
 - 31 • During the 2003-2004 school year Bass and Student A engaged in an
 - 32 inappropriate romantic relationship.

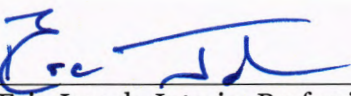
4) On December 4, 2025, Bass interviewed with TSPC investigative staff in the presence of his attorney, Sarah Drescher at the TSPC office in Salem, Oregon. During the interview, Bass denied ever having an inappropriate/romantic relationship with Student A.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The conduct described above in section 3 constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f) (Any sexual conduct with a student) as defined by OAR 584-020-0005(8) and ORS 339.370(12)(a); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1) (Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(b) (Refrain from exploiting professional relationships with any student for personal gain, or in support of persons or issues), OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(A) (Not demonstrating or expressing professionally inappropriate interest in a student's personal life), and OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in conduct and conversations at all times).

The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

1 **ORDER**

2 The Commission adopts the above Stipulation of Facts and hereby revokes Isaac J. Bass'
3 Oregon educator license.
