3 bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Final
4 Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or
5 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and
6 entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or
7 representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final
8 Order; and (vii) she has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and
9 Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to her rights thereto or waives
10 any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this
11 Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order
12 below.

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STIPULATION OF FACTS

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1. Gonzales submitted an application to the Commission for a substitute teaching license on December 11, 2025.
2. On December 30, 2025, TSPC received an internal referral from licensure staff. The referral indicated that Gonzalez failed to disclose prior criminal history from 2014, 2015, and 2017 on her application for substitute teaching licensure.
3. An investigation into this matter determined the following:
 - On Gonzalez's application for substitute teaching license with TSPC, she was required to answer all questions on the application honestly.
 - Question eight (8) on the application reads:
 - Have you ever been convicted or been granted a diversion or conditional discharge by any court for any: (a) Felony; or (b) Misdemeanor; or (c) Major traffic violation including but not limited to: driving under the influence of intoxicants or drugs; reckless driving; fleeing from or attempting to elude a police

1 officer; driving while your license was suspended, revoked or
2 used in violation of any license restriction; or failure to perform
3 the duties of a driver or witness at an accident?
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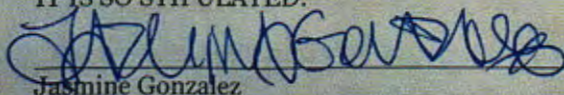
- 5 • Gonzalez answered "yes" to this question, but provided the following
6 written statement in the "explain" box:
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8 ○ "Over 8 years ago I had a driving while suspended."
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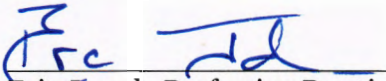
- 10 • Background documentation from Oregon State Police showed the
11 following criminal history for Gonzalez:
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- 13 ○ January 22, 2014, arrested for Hindering Prosecution and
14 Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. – No complaint was filed.
15 ○ April 24, 2014, arrested for Improper Use of 911. Florence
16 Municipal Court disposition - Convicted Misdemeanor.
17 ○ June 13, 2014, arrested for Criminal Mischief 2nd degree.
18 (Property damage) Florence Municipal Court disposition-
19 Convicted Misdemeanor.
20 ○ June 8, 2015, arrested for Theft in the 3rd degree. Florence
21 Municipal Court disposition – Convicted Misdemeanor.
22 ○ August 8, 2017, arrested for felony Unlawful Possession of
23 Methamphetamine and Interfering with a Police officer.
24 Florence Municipal Court disposition (Possession) –
25 Dismissed; disposition (Interference) – Convicted
26 Misdemeanor.

9 *district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations).*

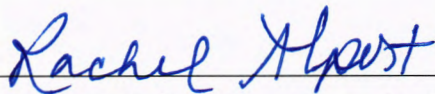
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11 **ORDER**

12 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and

14 of probation. The period of probation will become effective on the date of adoption of
15 this stipulated order. The period of probation is subject to the following conditions:

19 Chapter 584, Division 020.
