

3. On January 18, 2009, Meyers was arrested by the Portland Police Department for Prostitution Procurement, a local ordinance and an unclassified misdemeanor. On February 2, 2009, these charges were dismissed. Review of the associated police report indicates Meyers did attempt to solicit a prostitute.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Meyers's 2006 conviction for prostitution as described in section two (2) above constitutes gross unfitness pursuant to ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(d) (*Commission of an act list in OAR 584-020-0040(1)*), because ORS 167.007- Prostitution (OAR 584-020-0040(1)(kk)) is a crime listed in OAR 584-020-0040(1). The conduct that led to your conviction also constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*).


Meyers' conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross neglect of duty and gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b) and ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*); and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (*Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even in the absence of a conviction*) specifically: OAR 584-020-0040(1)(kk) (ORS 167.007 – Prostitution).

The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

FINAL ORDER

The Commission hereby revokes Fred Scott Meyers' right to apply for a teaching license. IT IS SO ORDERED THIS 10th day of May, 2012.
