STIPULATION OF FACTS AND  
FINAL ORDER OF DENIAL OF  
LICENSE RENEWAL

On March 16, 2011, Hall was internally referred for investigation regarding teaching without the proper license.

After review of the matters alleged, Hall and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the denial of his substitute teaching license application.

By signing below, Hall acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order; (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request to the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Hall nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

1. Hall was first licensed by the Commission on September 30, 1980. Hall was issued a Basic Teaching License with an endorsement in Basic Biology. Hall last held a Substitute Teaching license that expired on January 14, 2011. On or about December 10, 2010, the Commission received Hall's application for renewal of his Substitute Teaching license.





