DEFAULT ORDER OF
LICENSE REVOCATION AND
REVOCATION OF RIGHT TO APPLY
FOR LICENSE

On May 7, 2010, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Zuleyma Fernanda Figueroa (Figueroa) in which the Commission charged her with Gross Neglect of Duty pursuant to OAR 584-020-0040(1)(fff). The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7009 1410 0002 1902 5153 to the address on file with the Commission. Ms. Figueroa signed for the Certified Mail on May 8, 2010. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing dated May 7, 2010, and signed by Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director, stated:

"If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice."

Ms. Figueroa did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Ms. Figueroa to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

FINDINGS OF FACT

On March 5, 2010, in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County, Ms. Figueroa pled guilty and was convicted of Unlawful Delivery of Methamphetamine.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Zuleyma Fernanda Figueroa's criminal conviction for Unlawful Delivery of Methamphetamine constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of: OAR 584-020-0040(1)(fff) and ORS 475.890. The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
