On October 3, 2000, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Randall Scott Lipkin in which the Commission proposed to suspend or revoke the teaching license of Randall Scott Lipkin or otherwise impose discipline under ORS 342.177. The notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt Z 294 586 817. The certified mail receipt was signed and dated by Randall Lipkin on October 16, 2000. The Notice of Opportunity for Hearing signed by David V. Myton, Executive Director, stated:

“You, Randall Scott Lipkin, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice.”

Based on the foregoing, the Commission finds Mr. Lipkin in default and such default is hereby entered. Based on the records and files of the Commission, the Commission enters the following findings of fact and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

On June 20, 2000, Randall Scott Lipkin pled guilty and was convicted of ORS 163.465
Public Indecency in Circuit Court Multnomah County, Oregon.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Randall Scott Lipkin's license is hereby revoked on the grounds that he was convicted
