



Jeffrey Strong enters into this Stipulation of Facts with knowledge that the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission will place him on Probation for a period of eight months and 15 days from the date the Commission adopts the Order. During the probation, Strong will be required to complete an alcohol treatment program and to comply with Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educators. This Stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Mr. Strong nor the Commission are bound by these stipulations and Mr. Strong retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.

#### ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Jeffrey Strong was arrested in May 1999 for DUII and was permitted to enter a diversion agreement.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Under ORS 342.175 and OAR 584, Division 020, educators are required to be law-abiding citizens and exemplify good examples for students.

#### ORDER

The Commission confirms the issuance of a teaching license to Jeffrey Strong for employment in The Dalles School District. Mr. Strong shall be placed on Probation from September 17, 1999 through June 2, 2000. During this period of probation Mr. Strong shall complete, at his expense, an alcohol treatment program as required by the McMinnville Municipal Court and shall conduct himself as a law-abiding citizen. On conclusion of the period of probation, Mr. Strong will be required to provide documentation of compliance with the terms of probation.
