

1 4. On or about February 1, 2005, Jason Michael Ray was convicted of two counts of
2 Official Misconduct I, ORS 162.415, in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of
3 Klamath.

4 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5 Mr. Ray's criminal convictions in this matter, Sexual Abuse III and Official Misconduct I,
6 are the result of sexual acts involving Klamath County Public School students. The crime of
7 Sexual Abuse III as defined in ORS 163.415 is listed in ORS 342.143(3). The Commission is
8 required to revoke the Oregon Standard Teaching License issued to Jason Michael Ray and
9 revoke his right to apply for a license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2).

10 Mr. Ray's convictions for Official Misconduct I, ORS 162.415 constitute Gross Unfitness
11 in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this
12 matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

13 **ORDER**

14 The Commission hereby revokes the Oregon Standard Teaching License issued to
15 Jason Michael Ray and revokes his right to apply for a teaching license.
