FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Michael Owen Newby held an Oregon Basic Teaching License valid from October 13, 1994 until December 20, 1997.
2. In December 1997, Michael O. Newby was charged in Skamania County, Washington State, with incest and sexual misconduct with a minor.
3. On January 5, 1998, Mr. Newby resigned from a contracted teaching position in Mill A School District, Cook, Washington, as a result of the above indictment.
4. On February 24, 1998, Mr. Newby voluntarily surrendered his Washington Teaching Certificate #340377A to the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
5. On July 2, 1998, Mr. Newby pled guilty to Child Molestation in the Third Degree in Skamania County, Washington State.
