FINDINGS OF FACT

1 herself as a law-abiding citizen and beginning November 9, 2003, submit biannual reports to the
2 Commission of her compliance with her treatment plan.

3 3. On July 15, 2003, Ms. Martin was convicted of Theft II in the Circuit Court of the
4 State of Oregon for Washington County.

5 4. On November 9, 2003, Ms. Martin failed to provide evidence to the Commission of
6 compliance with the treatment plan.

7 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8 Ms. Martin's criminal conviction for Theft II and her failure to provide evidence of
9 compliance with the treatment plan constitute Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-
10 020-0040(4)(k). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
11 ORS 342.175.

12 ORDER

13 The Commission hereby revokes the Oregon Standard Teaching License issued to
14 Shelley Ann Martin.
