DEFAULT ORDER OF
LICENSE REVOCATION

"You, Rose Mary Mann, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice. Attached to this notice is a copy of the procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of a hearing as required under ORS 183.413(2)."

FINDINGS OF FACT

2. Ms. Mann was employed by Chemawa Indian School as a substitute teacher beginning March 20, 1995.

1 3. On January 2, 2003, the Commission received a report from Larry Byers,
2 Superintendent, Chemawa Indian School alleging that Ms. Mann was not mentally capable of
3 performing her duties as a teacher.

4 4. Ms. Mann failed to respond to requests for information, furnish documents or
5 participate in an interview with a Commission representative relating to a Commission
6 investigation.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 The above conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-
9 0040(4)(p). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
10 342.175.

11 **ORDER**

12 The Commission hereby revokes the Oregon Standard Teaching License issued to Rose
13 Mary Mann.
