

1 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2
3 ORS 342.553 requires the suspension of a license for the balance of the school year
4 for failure to provide 60 days' notice prior to resignation. If the charge of the contract
5 violation is proven, and justification for the contract violation is not satisfactory, the
6 Commission is required to suspend the license for the remainder of the school year.
7 The Commission's decision is final.

11 The Commission suspends the Oregon Teaching License #303414, issued to Stacey
12 Carlson, for violation of contract by resignation without providing 60
13 days' written notice.
