DEFAULT ORDER OF  
LICENSE REVOCATION

**"You, William Stafford Durler, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. Attached to this notice is a copy of the procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of a hearing as required under ORS 183.413(2)."**

## FINDINGS OF FACT

2. Mr. Durler was employed by the Beaverton School District as a Computer Science Teacher from August of 1999 to June 1, 2002.

1 3. On September 26, 2002, William Stafford Durler was convicted of two counts of  
2 Sexual Abuse, ORS 163.427, in the Circuit Court for the State of Oregon for the County of  
3 Washington.

4 4. On September 26, 2002, William Stafford Durler was convicted of Unlawful Sexual  
5 Penetration I, ORS 163.411, in the Circuit Court for the State of Oregon for the County of  
6 Washington.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 The crimes of Sexual Abuse I as defined in ORS 163.427; and Unlawful Sexual  
9 Penetration I as defined in ORS 163.411 are listed in ORS 342.143(3). The Commission is  
10 required to revoke the Oregon Standard Teacher License issued to William Stafford Durler  
11 pursuant to ORS 342.175(2).

12 **ORDER**

13 The Commission hereby revokes the Oregon Standard Teacher License issued to  
14 William Stafford Durler.
