2. Mr. Perry began employment with Nyssa School District as a licensed teacher in August of 2003. On December 19, 2005, Mr. Perry was placed on administrative leave.

3. On May 15, 2006, Mr. Perry was convicted of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree, ORS 163.425, in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. Mr. Perry was sentenced to 90 days in jail, fined \$2,673 and placed on supervised probation for a period of 36 months.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Matthew Allen Perry's conviction of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree, ORS 163.425, is listed in ORS 342.143(3). The Commission is required to revoke the Restricted Transitional Teaching License and Transitional Teaching License issued to Mr. Perry and revoke his right to apply for a license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2). The Commission has the authority to impose discipline in this matter under ORS 342.120 through 342.430 and OAR Chapter 584.

## FINAL ORDER

The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and conclusion of law, and based thereon, hereby revokes the Restricted Transitional Teaching License and Transitional Teaching License issued to Matthew Allen Perry and revokes his right to apply for a teaching license.
