



2. On June 19, 2010, Dalrymple signed the character questions on her C-1 application for educator license.

a) Dalrymple answered "yes" to question #8 *"Have you ever been convicted or been granted conditional discharge by any court for: (a) any felony; (b) misdemeanor; or (c) any major traffic violation, such as: driving under the influence of intoxicants or drugs; reckless driving; fleeing from or attempting to elude a police officer; driving while your license was suspended, revoked, or used in violation of any license restriction, or failure to perform the duties of a driver or witness to an accident?"* and;

b) Dalrymple answered "yes" to question #11 *"Have you ever had a civil judgment or other court order entered against you resulting from abuse, assault, battery, harassment, intimidation, neglect, stalking, or other threatening behavior toward other persons?"*

c) Dalrymple answered "no" to question #10 *"Have you ever entered a plea of guilty or No Contest relative to any charge for an offense listed in question 8."*

3. Dalrymple disclosed a June 19, 2003, a guilty plea and violation conviction for Domestic Abuse in Pendleton, Oregon. This conviction was a violation and not a misdemeanor or felony and did not need to be reported.

4. Dalrymple did not report her October 1, 2002, conviction for Theft 2 (ORS 164.045), under the name Erin Roggiero, stemming from a December 15, 2001, arrest for theft at a K-Mart store in Pendleton Oregon. At that time Dalrymple was employed by the K-Mart and engaged in giving herself fraudulent refunds to a gift card, which Dalrymple then used to purchase goods from the store.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Dalrymple's conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0040(o) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0040(4)(c) (*Knowing falsification of any document or knowing misrepresentation directly related to licensure, employment, or professional duties*). This conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) (*Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty plea, no contest plea or any other means.*), OAR 584-020-0040(5)(b) (*Fraud or misrepresentation*), and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (*Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even in the absence of a conviction*).

5 The Commission hereby suspends Erin Michelle Dalrymple's right to apply for a teaching  
6 license in Oregon for one year.
