

2. Colette Diane Koretsky was employed as a Substitute Teacher at Salem-Keizer Public Schools.

3. On October 12, 1995, Colette Diane Koretsky was convicted of Theft II in the Municipal Court for Corvallis, Oregon.

4. On December 27, 2001, Colette Diane Koretsky was convicted of DUII in Linn County Circuit Court, Albany, Oregon and sentenced to 24 months probation.

5. On December 27, 2001, Colette Diane Koretsky was convicted for the felony crime of Manufacture of Controlled Substance-meth in Linn County Circuit Court, Albany, Oregon. Koretsky was sentenced to 24 months probation, required to pay a money judgment of \$2165, undergo mental health evaluation and comply with any recommended treatment.

6. On December 27, 2001, Colette Diane Koretsky was convicted of Stalking in Linn County Circuit Court, Albany, Oregon. The Court placed her on probation for 24 months concurrent with the probation set forth above.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Colette Diane Koretsky's criminal convictions constitute Gross Unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c) and (d); and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) and (e).

ORDER

The Commission revokes the Oregon Substitute Teaching License #~~120913~~¹²⁰⁹¹⁴ issued to Colette Diane Koretsky.
