DEFAULT ORDER  
REVOKING RIGHT TO  
REINSTATE LICENSE

On or about December 8, 1998, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission received a judgment and sentencing report from Multnomah County Circuit Court, indicating that Andrew Jay Lockwood had been convicted of three counts of Attempted Sex Abuse III on July 13, 1998. On January 15, 1999, the Commission took action to charge Lockwood with violation of TSPC Standards based on this conviction. The Executive Director notified Mr. Lockwood of intent to revoke his right to reinstate his teaching license, and to inform Lockwood of his opportunity for hearing. The notice, dated January 25, 1999, and signed by David V. Myton, Executive Director, stated:

"You, Andrew Jay Lockwood, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed revocation of your right to reinstate your Oregon Teaching License. If you desire a hearing, you must notify the Executive Director of the Commission, in writing, within 21 days of the date of this notice."

The notice of opportunity for hearing was sent by U.S. Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested #P 412 422 614. The receipt was signed on January 28, 1999 and returned to TSPC. Mr. Lockwood did not request a hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Andrew Jay Lockwood held a Basic Teaching License with elementary endorsement valid from June 7, 1995 to September 25, 1998.
2. On July 13, 1998, Andrew Jay Lockwood was convicted of three counts of Attempted Sex Abuse in the First Degree in Multnomah County Circuit Court. On December 3, 1998, Lockwood was sentenced to 32 months imprisonment; 60 months post-prison supervision; and ordered to pay \$5,000 in restitution to victims.
3. The crimes involved male elementary students in the David Douglas School District.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

On July 13, 1998, Andrew Jay Lockwood entered a plea of "guilty" and was convicted of three counts of Attempted Sex Abuse in the First Degree in Multnomah County Circuit Court.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Under ORS 342.175, the Commission may find a conviction for the above crimes to constitute Gross Unfitness under Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educator.

ORDER

The Commission revokes the right to reinstate the Oregon Teaching License #245606 , of Andrew Jay Lockwood, for conviction of the crime of Attempted Sex Abuse.


