DEFAULT ORDER OF
LICENSE REVOCATION

On August 10, 2005, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Daniel Colin Willey (Willey) in which the Commission charged him with misconduct under ORS 342.175. The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7005 0390 0005 5794 8378 to the address obtained by the Commission. On August 12, 2005, the U.S. Certified Mail was signed and returned to the Commission. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated August 10, 2005, and signed by Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director, stated:

"You, Daniel Colin Willey, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed action of the Commission. If you want a hearing, you must file a written request for a hearing with the Commission within 21 days of the date of this notice. Attached to this notice is a copy of the procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of a hearing as required under ORS 183.413(2)."

Mr. Willey did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Mr. Willey to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Mr. Willey holds an Initial Teaching License issued March 17, 2004, valid through March 9, 2007, with a Basic Mathematics endorsement. Mr. Willey is not currently employed as a licensed educator.

2. On May 7, 2004, the Commission adopted a Stipulation of Facts and Order of Probation. The Commission imposed a three-year probation which required bi-annual reports of compliance with an alcohol treatment plan.

1 3. On or before September 1, 2004, and March 1, 2005, Mr. Willey failed to make
2 reports to the Executive Director of his compliance with his treatment plan pursuant to the
3 Stipulation of Facts and Order of Probation adopted by the Commission on May 7, 2004.

4 4. Mr. Willey has refused to respond to the Commission's repeated requests for
5 additional information and compliance in this matter.

6 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

7 Daniel Colin Willey violated terms and conditions of an Order of Probation adopted by
8 the Commission on May 7, 2004, in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(k). This behavior
9 constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty. The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this
10 matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

11 **ORDER**

12 The Commission hereby revokes the Initial Teaching License issued to Daniel Colin
13 Willey.
