LAFRAMBOISE **PROBATION** 7 8 9 On February 8, 2018, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 10 (Commission) received a misconduct report from the Stanfield School District (SSD), 11 indicating possible professional misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Jeremy M. 12 LaFramboise, (LaFramboise.) 13 After review of the matters alleged, LaFramboise and the Commission agree that 14 their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a 15 stipulation to certain facts, the imposition of a suspension of LaFramboise's right to 16 apply for an Oregon educator license, and probation. 17 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 18 sanction to be imposed. LaFramboise stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained 19 in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of 20 law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, LaFramboise waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 21 22 By signing below, LaFramboise acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and 23 agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing 24 to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully 25 and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this 26 Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Suspension of Right to Apply and Probation 27 (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document 28 and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and 29 Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. 30 If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither LaFramboise nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has 31 32 fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and 33 consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no 34 35 promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and

Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and

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1 Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any 2 and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final 3 Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below. 4 5 STIPULATION OF FACTS 6 7 1. The Commission has licensed LaFramboise since July 9, 2013. LaFramboise 8 held a Preliminary Teaching License, with endorsements in Health, Legacy 9 Middle Level, and Physical Education (all PK-12) valid from November 16, 10 2016, through November 20, 2019. During all relevant times, LaFramboise was employed by the Stanfield School District (SSD) as a substitute teacher. 11 12 13 2. On February 8, 2018, the Commission received a report from the SSD 14 indicating that while substitute teaching in a physical education class at 15 Stanfield High School, LaFramboise directed several inappropriate and 16 threatening comments to students. LaFramboise then left the class unsupervised and left the school. 17 18 19 3. Investigation determined that on February 7, 2018, LaFramboise was 20 providing substitute teaching services at Stanfield High School. At 21 approximately 1:00 p.m., LaFramboise got in a verbal altercation with students in his physical education class. Multiple witnesses report that 22 23 LaFramboise made several inappropriate and threatening comments to students, including statements about "popping" a student in the mouth. 24 25 Witnesses report that LaFramboise yelled the comments at students and acted aggressively and unprofessionally. One student confronted LaFramboise 26 27 on his behavior and went to the school office to report the matter to school staff. LaFramboise then left the class unsupervised and left the school 28 29 grounds. As LaFramboise was leaving, he told school staff "you can have these kids back. I am done." 30 31 32 The district immediately investigated this matter, and interviewed the 33 students in LaFramboise's class. Based on the consistency of the student 34 statements, the district immediately banned LaFramboise from substitute 35 teaching for the SSD permanently. 36 37 38 IT IS SOISTIPULATED: 3/5/2021 Date / 2021 39 40 Jeromy M. 3	The conduct described in sections two (2), and three (3) above constitutes gros
4	neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as i
5	incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020
6	0020(2)(d) (Skill in the supervision of students), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using
7	district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b
8	(Skill in communicating with administrators, students, staff, parents, and other
9	patrons).
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12	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
13	ORS 342.175.
14	ORDER
15	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
16	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a six (6) month suspension upon Jeremy
17	M. LaFramboise's right to apply for an Oregon educator license. Prior to submitting an
18	application for reinstatement of licensure, Jeremy M. LaFramboise is required to
19	complete a mental health evaluation from Commission approved provider.
20	Additionally, the Commission imposes a three (3) year period of probation to commence
21	upon reinstatement of Jeremy M. LaFramboise's Oregon educator license. Upon
22	reinstatement of LaFramboise's Oregon educator license, the following terms and
23	conditions will apply:
24	 LaFramboise must complete a Commission approved Classroom
25	Management course during the first year of probation.
26	2. LaFramboise shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical
27	Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules
28	Chapter 584, Division 20.
29	Violation of any term shall constitute an independent basis for the Commssion to revoke
30	LaFramboise's Oregon educator license or otherwise impose discipline, after first
31	providing LaFramboise with notice and opportunity for hearing.
