8	On September 2, 2020, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
9	(Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Ronald G. Alley (Alley) in
10	which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice was sent via
11	U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7019 2970 0000 4904 0792 to the
12	address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the
13	record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail was returned to the
14	Commission. The first class mail was not returned to the Commission and assumed
15	delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated September 2, 2020, and signed by
16	Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:

IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE." Alley did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Alley to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
32	FINDINGS OF FACT
33	1. Alley has been licensed by the Commission since April 9, 1990. Alley currently
34	holds a Professional Administrator License, with an endorsement in
35	Administrator (PK-12), valid from October 19, 2015, through July 27, 2021.
36	During all relevant times, Alley was employed by the Scappoose School District
37	(SSD).

1 2. On September 26, 2018, the Commission received a report from the SSD 2 indicating Alley may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty and/or gross 3 unfitness. Specifically, Alley was unprofessional towards a staff member. 4 3. Investigation determined that Alley admitted to sending a text message to a staff 5 member on January 11, 2018, indicating the staff member was the cause of two 6 out of three lawsuits pending against the district, and the staff member would 7 soon be responsible for a third lawsuit. On January 11, 2018, Alley emailed his 8 mentor, who also was the staff member's evaluator, about the staff member. Alley shared details of a text message exchange with the staff member in which the 9 10 staff member boasted of their new companion's sexual prowess being better than 11 Alley's. Alley also wrote the staff member, "has mental issues that keep her from 12 completiing (sic) her duties." 13 14 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** 15 Ronald G. Alley's conduct, as described above, constitutes gross neglect of duty in 16 violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0010(1) (Recognize the worth and 17 dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using 18 district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b) (Skill 19 20 in communicating with administrators, students, staff, parents, and other patrons). 21 22 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 23 342.175. 24 25 FINAL ORDER The Commission hereby issues a Public Reprimand upon Ronald G. Alley's Oregon 26 27 educator license. 28
