On September 26, 2018, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
(Commission) received reports from the Oregon City School District (District) indicating
Jeffrey N. Grimes (Grimes) may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty and/or
gross unfitness, specifically, that Grimes was under the influence of intoxicants at his
assigned place of duty.

After review of the matters alleged, Grimes and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, the imposition of a sixty (60) day suspension, and a two (2) year period of probation.

16 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 17 sanction to be imposed. Grimes stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the 18 Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set 19 forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Grimes waives the right to a hearing to 20 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.

21 By signing below, Grimes acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 22 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest 23 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 24 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 25 Facts and Final Order of Suspension and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) 26 this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon 27 request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and 28 subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not 29 approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Grimes nor the 30 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and 31 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or 32 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of 33 the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has 34 been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 35 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully

advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an
 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of
 the Stipulated Final Order below.

4 STIPULATION OF FACTS 5 1. The Commission has licensed Grimes since June 12, 2002. Grimes holds a 6 Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in Any Specialty (PreK-12), 7 valid from November 1, 2017, through December 20, 2020. During all relevant 8 times, Grimes was employed by the Oregon City School District (OCSD). 9 2. On September 26, 2018, the Commission received a report from the OCSD 10 indicating Grimes may have committed an act which constitutes gross neglect of 11 duty. The district reported Grimes had been under the influence of alcohol while 12 providing substitute teaching services at the Jackson Campus on or about 13 September 25, 2018. 14 3. Investigation determined that on September 25, 2018, Grimes was under the 15 influence of alcohol when he reported for work for the OCSD. School staff smelled 16 alcohol on Grimes and an investigation was immediately conducted. At the request of 17 district officials, Grimes consented to a blood alcohol test. At 1:19PM, Grimes tested 18 positive for alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.087%, and at 1:36PM, Grimes 19 tested positive for alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.085%. During the district 20 and Commission investigation, Grimes admitted to drinking alcohol heavily the night 21 before because he was "unable to sleep." Grimes indicated he drank "much later"

than he intended to, drinking into the morning hours of September 25, 2018. OCSD

terminated Grimes' substitute teaching employment after determining Grimes'

alcohol consumption. Grimes enrolled in a treatment program.

conduct violated district policy based on the test results and Grimes' admission of

3	neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it		
4	incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-		
5	0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-		
6	020-0040(4)(g) (Appearing on duty or at any district-sponsored activity while under		
7	the influence alcohol or any controlled substance).

9	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon		
10	ORS 342.175.		
11			
12	ORDER		
13	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and		
14	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a sixty (60) day suspension upon Jeffrey		
15	N. Grimes' Oregon educator license.		
16	Furthermore, the Commission imposes a period of two (2) years of probation		
17	upon Grimes' licensure to commence upon reinstatement and subject to the following		
18	condition:		
19	1. Grimes shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance		
20	of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division		
21	020.
