On October 30, 2020, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Timothy L. Yee (Yee) in which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty and Gross Unfitness. The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7019 2970 0000 4904 0877 to the address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail return receipt was signed by the postal carrier as delivered for COVID-19 concerns on November 2, 2020 and returned to the Commission. The regular first class mail was not returned to the Commission, and assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated October 30, 2020, and signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:

“IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE.”

Yee did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Yee to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Timothy L. Yee has been licensed by the Commission since July 29, 2013. Yee’s Preliminary Teaching License, with endorsements in Legacy Middle Level (PK-12), Social Studies (PK-12), Health (PK-12), and Physical Education (PK-12); was valid
