9	On June 3, 2020, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission)
10	issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Paul A. Jones (Jones) in which the
11	Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice was sent via U.S. First
12	Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7018 1830 0001 6178 2997 to the address on file
13	with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes
14	of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail receipt was returned to the Commission
15	signed. The first class mail was not returned to the Commission and assumed delivered. The
16	Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated June 3, 2020, and signed by Anthony Rosilez,
17	Executive Director, stated:

28	Jones did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Jones to be in default and
29	enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the files
30	and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
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32	FINDINGS OF FACT
33 34 35 36 37 38 39 40	 Jones currently holds a Standard Teaching License, with endorsements in Basic Health Education (PK-12) and Basic Standard Physical Education (Pk-12), valid from June 2, 2015, through June 1, 2020. Additionally, Jones currently holds a Professional Administrator License, with endorsements in Administrator (PK-12), valid from June 1, 2017, through June 1, 2022. During all relevant times, Jones was employed by the Coquille School District (CSD) as Director of Campuses at the Winter Lakes Schools.

inappropriate behavior towards a female student to law enforcement in October of 2017. In March of 2019, it was reported that the same male student, DT, sexually assaulted a different female student. Jones failed to report this information to law enforcement as well. Law enforcement learned of the assault when the same female student reported the matter to a different school staff member, who did report the matter to law enforcement. Based on this information, law enforcement investigated the matter and filed multiple criminal sexual assault charges against DT. Seven

Superintendent. The report indicates Jones failed to report a male student's (DT)

- victims were identified by the law enforcement investigation, all minor aged females. CSD issued Jones a Letter of Reprimand for failing to comply with mandatory
- reporting obligations and placed Jones on unpaid administrative leave for ten days.
- 3. On February 27, 2020 Jones met with TSPC investigative staff in the presence of Jones' attorney for an in-person interview. During that interview, Jones admitted he failed to make a mandatory report by failing to report these matters to his supervisor and law enforcement. Jones indicated that CSD reprimanded him for failing to make a mandatory report and stated that he did not contest the district's actions because
- he "understood that he failed." During the interview, Jones also indicated that he had learned student-to-student harassment reports should be handled with the same
 - level of seriousness as adult-to-student harassment reports. Jones reported to TSPC
 - investigative staff that this was a "huge wake-up call on reporting."
 - CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
- 1. Paul A. Jones' conduct, as described above, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation
 - of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-
 - 0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful
 - and reasonable rules and regulations), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(s) (Failing to report
 - child abuse pursuant to ORS 419B.010).
 - The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
 - FINAL ORDER
 - The Commission hereby issues a public reprimand upon Paul A. Jones' Oregon
- educator license.
