13	of	proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail receipt was signed by Martin and returned
14	to	the Commission. The first class mail was not returned to the Commission and assumed
15	de	livered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated July 22, 2020, and signed by
16	An	nthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:

27	Martin did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Martin to be in default	
28	an	nd enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the
29	file	es and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

31		FINDINGS OF FACT
32	1.	Martin has been licensed by the Commission since April 19, 1993. Martin currently
33		holds a Preliminary Teaching License, with an endorsement in Elementary-Multiple
34		Subjects (PK-12), valid from June 18, 2020, through October 14, 2023. During all
35		relevant times, Martin was employed by the Adel School District.
36		

2. Investigation determined that on June 13, 2018, Martin completed an online 1 2 application for renewal of a Restricted Teaching License. On June 30, 2018, the 3 Commission gave Martin a ninety (90) day grace period to complete her application. On August 7, 2018, the Commission sent Martin notice of an incomplete application 4 5 notice which provided a list of documents that Martin needed to submit for her 6 application to continue being processed. On September 12, 2018, the Commission 7 received most of the documents. On October 28, 2018, Martin contacted the 8 Commission and was reminded to submit a missing document. On October 29, 2018, 9 Martin's grace period expired. On November 12, 2018, having failed to receive all the documents necessary to process Martin's application, the Commission closed her 10 11 application and sent Martin notice of this action. In the notice was a statement which read, "...this means that you (Martin) no longer have a valid Restricted License and 12 cannot be in the classroom." From October 30, 2018, through the end of the 2018-13 14 2019 school year, Martin taught without a valid Commission license. On June 13, 15 2019, Martin contacted the Commission regarding her license and confirmed she 16 had taught the entire 2018-2019 school.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Stacey I. Martin's conduct, as described above, constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0040(4)(r) (Working without a license); and OAR 584-050-0035 (1) (Any person employed in a position in a school district, education service district, or charter school for which a license or registration is required pursuant to ORS Chapter 342, must hold a valid license or registration appropriate for the assignment while working as a public school, education service district or charter school employee).
