



1 2017 through July 17, 2022. During all relevant times, Hamann were employed by  
2 the Eugene 4J School District (E4JSD).

3  
4 2. On July 31, 2019, TSPC received an educator misconduct report alleging Hamann  
5 had been arrested on July 26, 2019 on charges of prostitution, sex abuse 2, sex abuse  
6 3, and sodomy. The charges stemmed from an investigation and sting conducted by  
7 local and federal law enforcement.

8  
9 3. According to law enforcement records, between May 1, 2018 and June 16, 2019,  
10 Hamann contacted CM, a minor aged female, for sex using social media. During the  
11 time frame above, Hamann engaged in sexual conduct with CM, including oral sex,  
12 sexual intercourse, and sexual touching. The records indicate that Hamann paid for  
13 the sexual encounters with CM and video-taped the sexual encounters for his own  
14 personal gratification. On January 19, 2021, Hamann plead guilty to a charge of Sex  
15 Trafficking of a Minor in US District Court, District of Oregon. On this charge  
16 Hamann was sentenced to 156 months in federal prison, 10 years supervised release,  
17 and a requirement to registers as a sex offender. On March 9, 2021, Hamann also  
18 pled guilty to charges of Sodomy 3, and Sex Abuse 2 in Lane County Oregon Circuit  
19 Court. For these charges Hamann was sentenced to 24 months incarceration and 24  
20 months post-prison supervision. Per Oregon State Law, under ORS 342.175(2) and  
21 OAR 584, Division 020, the Commission will deny, revoke or deny the right to apply  
22 for a license or charter school registration to any applicant or educator who, has been  
23 convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143, or the substantial equivalent of  
24 any of those crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction or convicted of attempt to  
25 commit such crimes as defined in 161.405.

26  
27 4. TSPC attempted to contact Hamann to arrange for an interview regarding this  
28 incident, multiple times. Below are the listed contacts and attempted contacts by  
29 TSPC staff:  
30

- 1 • On March 25, 2021, a request to interview letter (first class and certified)  
2 was mailed to Hamann at the Multnomah County Jail. TSPC received no  
3 response.
- 4
- 5 • TSPC was advised by Hamann’s father that his attorney was Rebecca  
6 Davis, and his father requested that we contact Ms. Davis about Hamann’s  
7 case.
- 8
- 9 • On April 6, 2021, TSPC sent an email to Ms. Davis about Hamann’s case  
10 and requested an interview with him. TSPC received no response.
- 11
- 12 • On April 21, 2021, TSPC left a voice message for Ms. Davis at her office.  
13 As of the writing of this Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, no response  
14 from Ms. Davis has been received.

### 16 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

17 William C. Hamann’s criminal convictions as described in section three (3)  
18 above, constitute gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-  
19 020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional  
20 judgment); and OAR 584-020-0040(1) (The Commission will deny, revoke or deny  
21 the right to apply for a license or charter school registration to any applicant or  
22 educator who, has been convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143, or the  
23 substantial equivalent of any of those crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction, or  
24 convicted of attempt to commit such crimes as defined in ORS 161.405 ), including  
25 ORS 163.684 – Encouraging Child Sexual Abuse in the First Degree. This conduct  
26 also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-  
27 0040(5)(c) (Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction  
28 includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty  
29 plea, no contest plea or any other means); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(d) (Commission  
30 of an act listed in OAR 584-020-0040(1); and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (Admission

1 of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even in the absence of a  
2 conviction).


3 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based  
4 upon ORS 342.175.

5 **FINAL ORDER**

6 The Commission hereby permanently revokes William Hamann's Oregon  
7 educator license, and his right to apply for an Oregon educator license.
