8		reported via a Public Complaint Form submitted to TSPC by Casey Woolley,			
9		Director of Human Resources for the Woodburn School District on October 30,			
10		2019.

12	3.	Investigation by the Woodburn Police Department (WPD) revealed the following:			
13		• Federico engaged in a sexual relationship with a JE, a seventeen (17) year-			
14		old female student at WHS.			
15		<ul> <li>The relationship first became sexual on May 5, 2018.</li> </ul>			
16		<ul> <li>Federico engaged in oral sex with JE frequently from May 2018 to July</li> </ul>			
17		2019.			
8		<ul> <li>Federico engaged in sexual intercourse with JE frequently from May 2018</li> </ul>			
9		to July 2019.			
20		• Federico sent and received nude and/or sexually explicit photographs and			
21		videos to/from JE from May 2018 to July 2019.			
22		• Federico told JE that he was going to leave his wife for a relationship with			
23		her.			
24		Federico and JE began trying to conceive a child together starting in			
25		December 2018.			
26		The relationship between Federico and JE became strained in early 2019.			
27		The relationship between Federico and JE ended in July of 2019.			
28		In late July or early August 2019 Federico offered to pay JE \$20,000.00			
29		cash to not go to the police.			
30		On or about August 21, 2019 Federico met up with JE and exchanged			
31		\$20,000,00 cash in exchange for a thumb drive containing sexually			

1 inappropriate pictures and videos Federico had sent JE. 2 On the same date, at the same meeting, Federico had JE sign a "Mutual 3 Non-Disclosure Agreement." The terms of the agreement contained a 4 clause stating JE would be required to pay back the \$20,000.00 if the 5 terms of the agreement were violated. On October 27, 2019 a search warrant was issued by the Marion County 6 7 Circuit Court, and Federico was taken into custody for the above-listed 8 crimes and searches were conducted of his person, his home, his vehicle 9 and his property at WHS. 10 On November 15, 2022, Federico plead guilty to eight (8) counts of Sex Abuse II, and two (2) counts of Luring a Minor. Federico was sentenced to 11 thirty (30) months in prison and fifty-seven (57) months of post-prison 12 13 supervision, and will be required to register as a sex offender upon his 14 release from prison. 15 4. On December 1, 2022 TSPC sent a Request to Interview letter to Federico's 16 residence at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility. On December 8, 2022 TSPC 17 18 received a phone call from Federico's wife, Kelly Federico, who called to inform 19 TSPC that upon advice of his attorney, Federico would be declining interviewing with TSPC. 20 21 22 Under ORS 342.175(2) and OAR 584, Division 020, the Commission will deny, revoke or deny the right to apply for a license or charter school 23 24 registration to any applicant or educator who, has been convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143, or the substantial equivalent of any of 25 those crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction or convicted of attempt to 26 commit such crimes as defined in 161.405. 27 28 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW 29 30 Under ORS 342.175(2) and OAR 584, Division 020, the Commission will deny, revoke or deny the right to apply for a license or charter school registration to any 31

1	applicant or educator who, has been convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS
2	342.143, or the substantial equivalent of any of those crimes if convicted in another
3	jurisdiction or convicted of attempt to commit such crimes as defined in 161.405.
4	
5	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
6	342.175.
7	FINAL ORDER
8	The Commission hereby permanently revokes Federico's teaching license.
9
