9 On September 2, 2020, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

10 (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Donna E. Blakley (Blakley)

11 in which the Commission charged her with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice was sent

12 via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7019 2970 0000 4904 0815 to

13 the address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as

14 the record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail was not

15 returned to the Commission. The regular first class mail was not returned to the

16 Commission, and both are assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing,

17 dated September 2, 2020, and signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:

18 “IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY
19 PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED
20 UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR
21 REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING,
22 WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, OR IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR
23 AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT
24 APPEAR AT HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF
25 DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF
26 YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE.”

28 Blakley did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Blakley to be in

29 default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order,

30 based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

32 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 33 1. Donna E. Blakley has been licensed by the Commission since August 2, 2018.
- 34 Blakley holds a Restricted Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in
- 35 Substitute Any Specialty (PK-12), valid from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022.
- 36 During all relevant times, Blakley was employed by the Salem-Keizer School District
- 37 (SKSD).
