On December 23, 2021, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Alanna C. Crabaugh (Crabaugh) in which the Commission charged Crabaugh with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7021 0350 0000 8183 8114 to the address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail receipt was not returned to the Commission, and assumed delivered. The regular First Class letter mail was not returned to the Commission, and assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated December 23, 2021, and signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:

“IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 60-DAY PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE.”


Crabaugh did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Crabaugh to be in default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Crabaugh applied for licensure with Commission. Crabaugh digitally signed and submitted an application for a Charter School Registry-Teaching, on February 3, 2020. Crabaugh’s application was pended until resolution of this matter
