8	On July 15, 2022, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission)
9	issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Nicholas G. Chorey (Chorey) in which the
10	Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty. On July 15, 2022, the Notice was sent
11	via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7021 0350 0000 8184 0940 to the
12	address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the
13	record for purposes of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail return receipt was
14	signed and returned to the Commission on July 25, 2022. The regular, First Class Mail was
15	not returned and assumed to have been delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing,
16	dated July 15, 2022, and signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:

IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR A HEARING, FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT A HEARING, THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE."
28	Chorey did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Chorey to be in default
29	and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the
30	files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
31	
32	FINDINGS OF FACT
33	1. Nicholas G. Chorey has been licensed by the Commission since December 13, 2018.
34	Chorey held a Restricted Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in
35	Substitute (PK-12), valid from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. During all
36	relevant times, Chorey was employed by ESS at Newport Middle School, Lincoln
37	Count School District (LCSD).

1	2.	On May 28, 2021, the Commission received a report from ESS indicating you may
2		have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness.
3		Specifically, the report alleged Chorey used inappropriate language in conversation
4		with students.
5		
6	3.	Investigation determined that on May 25, 2021, Chorey was substitute teaching a
7		language arts class at Newport Middle School. During the class, Chorey had a
8		conversation with several students which was not related to the lesson plan. In this
9		conversation, Chorey made comments which included racial and sexual epithets,
10		slurs, and other derogatory terms.
11		On Mayor, and a student reported the information to school administrators who
12	4.	On May 25, 2021, a student reported the information to school administrators who
13		then investigated the incident. Administrators interviewed multiple students who
14		confirmed Chorey's use of inappropriate language. During separate interviews with
15		ESS and the Commission, Chorey admitted to using the language reported by the students.
16		students.
17		CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
18		Nicholas G. Chorey's conduct described in section three (3) above constitutes gross
19	negle	ct of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it
20	incor	porates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-
21	0020	(2)(d) (Skill in the supervision of students), and OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using
22	distri	ct lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it
23	incor	porates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with
24	stude	nts in conduct and conversations at all times).
25		The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
26	342.1	75.
27		
28		FINAL ORDER
29		The Commission hereby suspends for thirty (30) days, Nicholas G. Chorey's right to
30	apply	for an Oregon educator license.
31		Furthermore, Chorey is subject to the following conditions:

1	1.	Chorey shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance
2		of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division
3		020.
4	2.	Prior to application, Chorey shall complete a Commission approved course on
5		communication skills and submit proof to the Commission of successful
6		completion of the training.
7
