SCHAEFER 7 8 9 On March 10, 2022 the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) 10 issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Michael J. Schaefer (Schaefer) in which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty. The Notice was sent via U.S. First 11 12 Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7021 0350 0000 8183 8268 to the address on file with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes 13 14 of proving a prima facie case. The first-class mail was not returned to the Commission and assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated March 10, 2022, and 15 signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated: 16 "IF A REOUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY 17 PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED 18 UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REOUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR 19 REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW 20 YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR 21 NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT HEARING, THE 22 COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE 23 THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER 24 DISCIPLINE." 25 26 Schaefer did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Schaefer to be in 27 default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based 28 on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter. 29 30 FINDINGS OF FACT 31 The Commission has licensed Schaefer since September 4, 2002. Schaefer holds an 32 1. Administrative License, with an endorsement in Principal (PK-12), valid from 33 January 16, 2020, through November 4, 2023. During all relevant times, Schaefer 34 was employed by the Klamath County School District (KCSD). 35 36 On June 1, 2021, the Commission received a School District Misconduct Report from 37 2. the Director of Human Resources for the KCSD. The report indicated Schaefer may 38

have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty and / or gross unfitness. 1 2 The report alleged that Schaefer reported for work at Mazama High School (MHS) under the influence of alcohol on May 17, 2021, and on August 9, 2021. 3 4 Investigation determined that on May 17, 2021, and August 9, 2021, Schaefer was 5 3. under the influence of alcohol while at work at MHS. 6 7 8 According to district records, on May 17, 2021, staff at MHS smelled alcohol on Schaefer's person and reported this to KSCD Human Resources. KCSD 9 administrative staff confronted Schaefer about smelling of alcohol, and he agreed to 10 submit to a breathalyzer test. The breathalyzer resulted in a positive test with a blood 11 alcohol level of .040. This test result was later confirmed via a urine sample 12 conducted by the Onsite Drug and Alcohol Testing Center, which also tested positive 13 for alcohol. For this incident, Schaefer was issued a letter of reprimand and 14 suspended for three days without pay. Schaefer also signed a last chance agreement 15 which directed that he follow any recommendations for treatment and random urine 16 screenings. At that time, Schaefer was referred to substance abuse treatment at 17 Reliant Behavior Health. 18 19 According to district records, on August 9, 2021, Schaefer was requested to complete 20 21 random drug/alcohol testing. A breathalyzer given to Schaefer that day tested positive for alcohol at .067 BAC level. A urine test, also given to Schaefer on August 9, 22 23 2021, tested positive at a .100 BAC. KCSD immediately placed Schaefer on leave and initiated an investigation. On August 12, 2021, Schaefer submitted his resignation to 24 25 the KCSD citing personal and family reasons. 26 27 The Commission reached out to Schaefer numerous times to request that he 4. 28 participate in an investigative interview. Schaefer was sent a request to interview via 29 USPS certified and regular mail on September 10, 2021. On November 2, 2021, the Commission emailed Schaefer at the last known email address on record. On 30 November 3, Schaefer responded to the email and reported that he was in Europe 31 32 and did not have cell phone coverage. Schaefer stated that he would not be disputing

1	the report or investigation. To date, Schaefer has not responded to those efforts to
2	contact him. Upon Schaefer's return from Europe, Commission staff arranged for
3	him to be interviewed via Zoom on November 22, 2021, at 11:00AM. On November
4	22, 2021, Commission investigative staff contacted Schaefer via the phone number he
5	provided for the interview, but the call went straight to voicemail. Commission staff
6	left a voicemail for Schaefer, requesting a call back. As of the writing of this Notice of
7	Hearing, Schaefer has not responded to Commission staff.
8	
9	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
10	The conduct described in sections two (2) and (3) above constitutes gross neglect of
11	duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR
12	584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district
13	lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(g) (Appearing
14	on duty or at any district-sponsored activity while under the influence of alcohol or any
15	controlled substance).
16	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
17	342.175.
18	FINAL ORDER
19	The Commission hereby issues a sixty-day (60) suspension and two years (2)
20	probation upon Michael Schaefer's Oregon educator license.
21
