8	On October 7, 2021, the Teacher St	andards and Practices Commission	
9	(Commission) received a misconduct repo	rt from the Sutherlin School District (District)	
10	indicating Gilbert Salas (Salas) may have committed acts of gross neglect of duty and/or		
11	gross unfitness. Specifically, the report alle	ged Salas failed to inform the district he was	
12	investigated by a school district where he previously worked and by the Commission.		
13	After review of the matters alleged,	Salas and the Commission agree that their	
14	respective interests, together with the pub.	ic interest, are best served by a stipulation to	
15	certain facts, to Revoke Salas' right to apply for an Oregon educator license.		
16	This Order sets forth the facts upor	which the parties have agreed and the	
17	sanction to be imposed. Salas stipulates th	at there are sufficient facts contained in the	
18	Commission's files and records to support	the findings of fact and conclusions of law set	
19	forth below. In entering into this stipulation	n, Salas waives the right to a hearing to	
20	contest the findings of fact, conclusions of	law and order set forth below.	
21	By signing below, Salas acknowled	ges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the	
22	following: (i) he has been fully advised of h	is rights to notice and a hearing to contest the	
23	findings of fact, conclusions of law, and or	ler set forth below, and fully and finally	
24	waives all such rights and any rights to app	peal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of	
25	Facts and Final Order to Revoke the Right	to Apply for Licensure (Stipulation and Final	
26	Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order	r is a public document and disclosed to the	
27	public upon request by the Commission; (i	ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is

29	Commission does not approve and adopt to	his Stipulation and Final Order, then neither	
30	Salas nor the Commission are bound by th	e terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this

32	any force or duress, enters into this Stipula	tion and Final Order and consents to issuance

and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

The Commission has licensed Salas since January 1, 2009. Salas held a
Preliminary School Counselor License, with an endorsement in Counselor (PK12), valid from February 4, 2020, through February 3, 2023. During all relevant
times, Salas was employed with the Klamath Falls City Schools (KFCS) or the
Sutherlin School District (SSD).

2. On April 9, 2020, the Commission opened investigation of Salas based on a misconduct report from the Klamath Falls City Schools (KFCS). The KFCS alleged Salas engaged in unprofessional relationships with students. On August 9, 2021, the Commission reviewed the matter and charged Salas with gross neglect of duty. On October 18, 2021, Salas signed a stipulated order agreeing with the Commission's stipulation of facts and conclusion of law. On November 5, 2021, the Commission adopted the stipulated order of discipline on Salas' license which included a six (6) month Suspension and a four (4) year period of probation.

3. On October 7, 2021, the Commission received a report from the SSD indicating Salas may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. Specifically, the report alleged Salas failed to inform the SSD of investigations by a previous employer and the Commission.

4. Investigation found that Salas was previously employed by, placed on administrative leave by, and investigated by the KFCS. Salas resigned his employment with the district in lieu termination. When applying for employment with the SSD in January 2021, Salas failed to disclose this information as part of the application's background information required by the SSD. On this same application, Salas failed to notify the SSD that he was the subject of a Commission investigation for the same allegations. On SSD application, Salas answered "No" to the following questions:

1	 Have you ever left any educational or school-related employment, 	
2	voluntarily or involuntarily, while the subject of an inquiry, review or	
3	investigation of alleged misconduct?

5	 Have you ever left educational or school-related employment when you 	
6	had reason to believe an investigation for misconduct was underway or	
7	imminent?

9	 Are you currently the subject of an inquire, review or investigation for 	
10	alleged misconduct or alleged violation of professional standards of	
11	conduct by either an employer or a licensure agency?	
12		
13	 Have you ever been placed on leave by your employer for any alleged 	
14	misconduct?	
15		
16	On January 12, 2021, Salas signed the application and affirmed all the	
17	information was "accurate, complete and truthful." On Salas' attached resume,	
18	he failed to list KFCS as an employer.

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1	duties); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates to OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a)

3	personal integrity and honesty).	
4	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS	
5	342.175.

8	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and	
9	conclusions of law, and based thereon, revokes Gilbert Salas' right to apply for an Oregon	
10	educator license.
