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8 On November 7, 2022, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

9 (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Larry P. Whitson

- 10 (Whitson) in which the Commission charged him with Gross Neglect of Duty and/or
- 11 Gross Unfitness. The Notice was sent via U.S. First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail
- 12 Receipt 7021 0350 0000 8184 4023 to the address on file with the Commission. The
- 13 Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes of proving a prima
- 14 facie case. The Certified Mail was not returned to the Commission, and assumed
- 15 delivered. The regular First Class mail was not returned to the Commission, and
- 16 assumed delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated November 7, 2022, and
- 17 signed by Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated:
- 18 "IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY 19 PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED 20 UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REOUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR 21 REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, 22 WITHDRAW YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, OR IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR 23 AT A HEARING, OR NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT 24 APPEAR AT HEARING. THE COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF 25 DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF 26 YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER DISCIPLINE." 27
- 28 On November 18, 2022, Whitson contacted the Commission by phone and declined a
- 29 hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Whitson to be in default and enters the
- 30 following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based on the files and
- 31 records of the Commission concerning this matter.
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FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Commission has licensed Larry P. Whitson since December 8, 2016. Whitson
- 35 currently holds a Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in Substitute
- 36 (PK-12), valid from July 218, 2021, through July 27, 2024. During all relevant
- 37 times, Whitson was employed by the Eagle Point School District (EPSD).

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- 2. On December 13, 2021, the Commission received a report from EPSD indicating Whitson had engaged in conduct that may be considered gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. Specifically, the district alleged Whitson engaged in inappropriate physical contact with a student while attempting to direct a student to the Eagle Point Middle School gymnasium.
- 7 3. Investigation found that on December 1, 2021, a student from the seventh period 8 physical education class went to the restroom. When the student exited the 9 10 restroom into the hallway, Whitson verbally instructed the student return to the 11 gymnasium, and pointed in the direction of the gymnasium. The student did not 12 comply. Instead, the student turned and began walking away from the 13 gymnasium. Whitson began moving towards the student. When Whitson caught 14 up to the student, he grabbed the shoulder of the student's hooded sweatshirt and 15 attempted to pull the student towards the gymnasium by holding the student's 16 arm. While walking towards the gymnasium, the student pulled away from 17 Whitson's grip and Whitson fell to the floor. Whitson stood up, grabbed the student by the wrist and again began pulling the student towards the gymnasium. 18
- On June 16, 2022, a Commission investigator sent a letter by Certified and First
 Class mail notifying Whitson of his requirement to participate in a Commission
 interview, and that if he failed to participate, it could result in discipline. On June
 23, 2022, Whitson contacted the investigator and declined to participate in an
 interview and Whitson declared he was no longer in the teaching profession.
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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The conduct as described in section three (3) above, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0020(2)(d)(*Skill in the supervision of students*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (*Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations*), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(d) (*Unreasonable physical force against students, fellow employees, or visitors to the school, except as permitted under ORS 339.250*).

1	The conduct described in section four (4) above constitutes gross neglect of duty		
2	in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR		
3	584-020-0040(4)(p) (Subject to the exercise of any legal right or privilege, failure or		
4	refusal by an educator under investigation to respond to request for information, to		
5	furnish or to participate in interviews with a Commission representative relating to a		
6	Commission investigation).		
7	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon		
8	ORS 342.175.		
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10	FINAL ORDER		
11	The Commission hereby revokes Larry P. Whitson's educator license.
