7 8	On July 27, 2022, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued
9	a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Sarah Swanson-Suhrstedt (Swanson-Suhrstedt) regarding
10	the Commission consideration regarding Swanson-Suhrstedt reinstatement of an Oregon
11	educator license on June 22, 2022.
12	After review of the matters, Swanson-Suhrstedt and the Commission agree that their
13	respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain
14	facts, and a condition for Swanson-Suhrstedt to apply for reinstatement of her license.
15	This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the condition for
16	application for reinstatement. Swanson-Suhrstedt stipulates to the findings of fact below.
17	By signing below, Swanson-Suhrstedt acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees
18	to the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to a hearing to contest the findings of
19	fact, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to
20	appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Order Allowing Application
21	Withdrawal (Stipulation and Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Order is a public document and
22	disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Order is
23	contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission
24	does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Order, then neither Swanson-Suhrstedt nor the
25	Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Order,
26	and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this
27	Stipulation and Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Order below; (vi) she
28	states that no promise or representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and
29	Order; and (vii) she has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Order and has
30	been fully advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with
31	an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Order and issuance and entry of the
32	Stipulated Order below.
33 34	HISTORY OF COMMISSION DISCIPLINE
35	On March 28, 2012, the Commission received a report from the Central Point School
36	District alleging Swanson-Suhrstedt's conduct constituted gross neglect of duty. The Commission

37 subsequently opened and completed an investigation into the allegations. On July 25, 2014, the

1	Commission revoked Swanson-Suhrstedt's right to apply for an Oregon educator license. On
2	January 8, 2014, Swanson-Suhrstedt declined to request a hearing and on January 10, 2014, the
3	Commission adopted a default order.
4	
5	FINDINGS OF FACT
6	1. On March 24, 2022, Swanson-Suhrstedt submitted an application to the Commission for
7	reinstatement of her Oregon teaching license. On April 4, 2022, an investigation was opened
8	to determine Swanson-Suhrstedt's fitness for reinstatement. On May 3, 2022, Swanson-
9	Suhrstedt was interviewed by Commission investigators.
10	2. On June 22, 2022, the Commission considered Swanson-Suhrstedt's application,
11	investigative report, and support materials.
12	3. On August 22, 2022, Swanson-Suhrstedt notified the Commission by letter that she was
13	requesting her application for reinstatement be withdrawn.

27	application for reinstatement.
28	Furthermore, as a condition of the acceptance, the Commission requires a waiting period
29	of four (4) months, to commence from the date the order is signed by the Commission, before
30	Swanson-Suhrstedt can apply for reinstatement.
