36	March 14, 2017, through July 2	29, 202	2. On March 3, 2022, Muniz submitted a
37	renewal application for her Or	egon ed	ucator license. Muniz's application was

- pended until resolution of the matter. During all relevant times, Muniz was employed by the Three Rivers School District (TRSD).
 - 2. On May 2, 2022, the Commission received information from Oregon's Department of Human Services (DHS) indicating Muniz may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. Specifically, DHS reported allegations Muniz had sexually abused a sixteen-year-old high school student enrolled in the TRSD. On May 31, 2022, the Commission received a misconduct report from the TRSD alleging Muniz may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. Specifically, that Muniz was involved in an inappropriate relationship with a student enrolled in the district.
 - 3. Investigation found that in during the 2020-21 school year, Muniz developed relationships with three (3) male, minor-aged high school students who regularly visited and ate lunch in Muniz's classroom at Illinois Valley High School, TRSD. As Muniz's relationships with the three students deepened, Muniz began communicating with the students via social media messaging or text. During the 2020-21 school year, Muniz's communications with the students became sexual in nature. On several occasions during the school year, Muniz sent inappropriate photos of herself to one of the students and this student sent Muniz an inappropriate photo of himself.
 - 4. On August 30, 2022, Muniz was indicted by a Josephine County Grand Jury of two (2) felony counts of ORS 163.432 Online Sexual Corruption of a Child in the Second Degree, and two (2) felony counts of ORS 167.057 Luring a Minor. On February 7, 2023, Muniz entered a plea of guilty to on one (1) felony count of ORS 176.057 Luring a Minor. On February 27, 2023, Muniz was sentenced to thirty (30) days in jail, thirty-six (36) months supervised probation, required to register as a sex offender, and fined.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Sarah R. Muniz's criminal conviction criminal convictions as described in section four (4) above, constitute gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional*

judgment); and OAR 584-020-0040(1) (The Commission will deny, revoke or deny the right to apply for a license or charter school registration to any applicant or educator who, has been convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143, or the substantial equivalent of any of those crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction), including ORS 167.057 - Luring a Minor. This conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) (Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty plea, no contest plea or any other means); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(d) (Commission of an act listed in OAR 584-020-0040(1)); and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even

in the absence of a conviction).

Pursuant to ORS 342.175(3) and OAR 584-020-0040(1) the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission must revoke Muniz's license and/or her right to apply for a license based on Muniz's conviction of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143(3)(a), or the substantial equivalent of any of those crimes, or convicted of attempt to commit such crimes as defined in ORS 161.405.

Muniz's conduct underlying her conviction, as described in section four (4) above, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a) (*Maintain the dignity of the profession by respecting and obeying the law, exemplifying personal integrity and honesty*).

Additionally, Muniz's criminal conviction and conduct related to Muniz's conviction constitute "gross unfitness" in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(3)(c) and (d) as defined by OAR 584-020-0040 (5) (Gross unfitness is any conduct which renders an educator unqualified to perform his or her professional responsibilities); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f) (Any sexual conduct with a student) as defined by OAR 584-020-0005(5); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in

2	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
