VAN HAALEN ) ) 7 FOR LICENSURE 8 9 In June 2022, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received an application for an Oregon Administrator License from Caspar W. van Haalen (van Haalen) 10 11 and conducted a background check which warranted further investigation. 12 After review of the application and additional background information, van Haalen and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best 13 14 served by a stipulation to certain facts, to deny van Haalen's pending application for an Oregon educator license and revoke van Haalen's right to apply for an Oregon educator license. 15 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed. Van Haalen stipulates 16 that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the 17 findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, van 18 Haalen waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order 19 20 set forth below. By signing below, van Haalen acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 21 22 following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the 23 findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all 24 such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order to Deny Application and Revocation of Right to Apply for Licensure (Stipulation and Final 25 Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public 26 upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and 27 subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 28 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither van Haalen nor the Commission are bound 29 by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it 30 completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final 31 32 Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final 33 34 Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order

and has been fully advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to

5	1.	On June 30, 2022, van Haalen digitally signed and sub-	mitted an application with the
6		Commission for an Oregon Administrator License. Van	
7		hold pending resolution of this matter.	
8			
9	2.	In August 2022, Commission staff reviewed van Haaler	a's application and during a
10		background check, found additional publicly available i	nformation that was inconsistence
11		with information provided by van Haalen on his applica	ation.
12			
13	3.	A Commission investigator attempted to contact van Ha	aalen in July 2023, to arrange an
14	interview. The interview was to cover the information from van Haalen's background which would allow the Commission to more thoughtfully assess his fitness to hold an Oregon teaching license or Charter School Registry. Van Haalen contacted the investigator on		
15

17	August 1, 2023, and indicated he no longer wished to obtain licensure from the Commission.		
18	The investigator informed van Haalen an interview was still required, and van Haalen		
19	declined to participate in an interview or further cooperate in the investigation.

6	The Commission hereby denies the application for Caspar W. van Haalen's and revokes		
7	Caspar W. van Haalen's right to apply for an Oregon educator license.
