This matter came before the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) on February 2, 2024, to consider the request by Kyle Bunch (Bunch) for reinstatement of his right to apply for an Oregon educator license which was revoked by stipulated agreement on July 26, 2013. The Commission determined Bunch is eligible for reinstatement under the Commission's rules.

After review of the matters, Bunch and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, and a two (2) year period of Probation with conditions for reinstatement of Bunch's right to apply for a license.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the conditions for reinstatement and probation with conditions. Bunch stipulates to the findings of fact below. By signing below, Bunch acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reinstatement and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Bunch nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

10	Stipulation of Facts, Final Order of Surrender and Revocation of Bunch's Oregon teaching		
11	license.

13	3. On September 12, 2023, the	Commission received Bunch's application for reinstatement

4	Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division 020.

6	2. Bunch will be required to successfully complete and provide evidence of Commission-	
7	approved trainings on classroom management and teacher/student boundaries, to	
8	commence within six (6) months upon issuance of this order.

10	Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for	
11	the Commission to revoke Bunch's Oregon educator license or otherwise impose discipline, after	
12	first providing Bunch with notice and opportunity for hearing.	
13	Now therefore, the Commission orders that Kyle Bunch's right to apply for an Oregon	
14	educator license is hereby reinstated effective April 5, 2024.
